BidAddendum 1: Pipe Jacketing

To all Prospective Bidders:

This addendum modifies the Bid Set Documents by the following:

- All exterior refrigerant piping that is insulated shall be installed with a UV and weather protective jacket. Pipe insulation jacket shall be equal to Johns Manville Zeston Cut and Curl jacket, white, UV resistant and of 30 mil thickness (minimum). All fittings shall be jacketed with the appropriate Zeston matching fitting jacket.
- 2. Jacketing shall be installed incompliance with the manufacturer's requirements.

- 1. Will the city allow a crane to set up on the convention center parking lot? Please provide details of any restrictions. Yes, as long as the convention center is not preparing for a major event that would require the use of that area for loading and unloading.
- 2. Would the city prefer a helicopter instead of crane for equipment removal and installation? No preference.
- 3. Will the city provide a designated area to stage equipment and storage? Yes, we will work with the contractor to provide a space in an adjoining parking lot.
- 4. Will the city provide a designated trash dumpster location close to the work location? Yes, we will work with the contractor to provide a space in an adjoining parking lot.
- 5. What is the approximate age of the building/facility? 50 years old.
- 6. M001 GENERAL NOTES #14 states three different trades to purchase, install and wire smoke detectors. Is there a reason Fire Alarm contractor could not do all three associated tasks? No.
- 7. M001 DEMOLITION NOTES # 1. Has the city/owner identified what old equipment it want to retain? We do not want to retain any old equipment from this project.
- 8. In the event asbestos like materials are discovered during the demolition phase, who's responsible for abatement? The city will arrange for and pay for unplanned abatement.
- 9. Do you want contractor to install construction plastic/paper to walk on in the foyer area? Or will this area be off limits to guest? The foyer area will remain open to the public.
- 10. What is the current lead time on equipment? Unknown, the construction NTP will begin once the contractor has received the equipment.
- 11. Will the city consider alternative manufactures for equipment? Yes, Trane, Carrier, Lennox, York, and Daikin.
