### **EXACT FARE IS REQUIRED. BUS OPERATORS DO NOT CARRY MONEY** AND CANNOT MAKE CHANGE OR GIVE REFUNDS.

### **FULL FARE (SINGLE RIDE) • \$1.50**

### No transfers. Cash only. **DAY PASS • \$3.00**

Unlimited fixed route rides for duration of calendar day during normal operating hours.

### 31-DAY PASS • \$40.00

Unlimited fixed route rides during a 31-day period. NOTE: The 31-day period does not start until the card is used for the first time on the bus.

### **31-DAY PASS (FOR STUDENTS K-12) • \$20.00** Waco Transit Student I.D. is required.

### **SUMMER STUDENT PASS (FOR STUDENTS K-12) • \$30.00** Waco Transit Student I.D. is required. Valid June, July & August. **REDUCED FARE DAY PASS • \$1.25**

### Waco Transit Senior or Disability I.D. is required.

STUDENT FARE (SINGLE RIDE) • \$1.00 Good for single one-way ride. Waco Transit Student I.D. is required. This may be purchased for \$5.00 from the Waco Transit dispatch office. You must be a student from 6 years of age through the 12th grade with paperwork documenting attendance to a recognized school.

Waco Transit Senior I.D. is required. Good for single one-way ride. You must be a citizen at least 65 years of age with proof of date of birth.

### Waco Transit Disability I.D. is required. Good for single one-way ride. **EVENING LINK • \$3.00 per trip**

or \$15.00 for a book of 5 single ride tickets

### **MEDICARE CARD HOLDER FARE • \$.50**

Waco Transit I.D. is required and can be obtained by presentation of a valid Medicare card to Waco Transit.


### **CHILDREN'S FARE • FREE!**

### **DISCOUNTED FARES**

If you meet the qualifications for a discounted fare and wish to apply. visit the Waco Transit dispatch office located at 301 S. 8th Street. ### **SCHEDULE OF SERVICE**

Bus service is provided every day, except on Sunday and is provided year-round—except for New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

## **OTHER SERVICES**

Waco Transit provides a para-transit van service for those with special transportation needs within the Greater Waco urbanized area. To find out more information about our para-transit service, call (254) 750-1620. A Marlin-to-Waco shuttle operates 4 times per day/5 days per week. A shuttle to Sanderson Farms is available 3 times per day/5 days per week. Additionally, Waco Transit provides the Evening LINK service from 8:30 p.m.–11:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday. The Evening LINK is a \$3 per trip shared-ride service that provides transportation options after normal city bus service has ended. Please call (254) 750-1620 at least 24-hours prior to book your trip. You may also call the Waco Transit dispatch office at (254) 750-1613 for more information about Marlin, Sanderson Farms or any Waco Transit service.

A Waco Regional Airport shuttle is also available. Please call the Scheduling Department for more information.

### **HOW TO RIDE THE BUS**

Time points indicated on this schedule represent the minutes past the hour that the bus departs from the location indicated. All routes depart from 8th Street and Mary Avenue at 15 minutes past the hour. On the schedule, this is indicated by "8th and Mary :15". Patrons should arrive at locations up to 5 minutes prior to the indicated times to avoid missing the bus.

Find the beginning and end point for your trip on this map. Find the name and number of the routes closest to your two points. Each route on the map is a different color, which matches the time schedules on the back of this map. By following the arrows on the route, you can see exactly where the bus will travel on that route. Estimate how long it will take the bus to go from the time point to your location. REMEMBER, YOU CAN CATCH THE BUS ANYWHERE ALONG THE ROUTE (when safe to do so) at most intersections along its route. Please catch the bus before it crosses the intersection. Saturday bus times may differ from weekday schedules. Make sure you are reading the correct part of the schedule for the day of the week that you wish to travel.

Waco Transit's Fixed Route bus service works as a "flag stop" system. Buses may be "flagged" by positioning yourself on the correct side of the street (well before any major intersections), attempting to make eye contact with the driver, and waving your arm up and down to flag him or her to stop. If safe, the bus operator will stop the vehicle as close to your location as possible. Please note that the "correct" side of the street means that you will be able to board the bus without having to go around to the other side of the vehicle. Operators are instructed NOT to stop for patrons on the opposite side of the street, along busy highways or near congested intersections. Safety is our first

# **HOW TO RIDE THE BUS, cont.**

When boarding the bus, please enter through the front door, pay the exact fare and take a seat. (The front seats of our vehicles are ADA-accessible.) Smoking, eating, or drinking is not permitted on the bus. Our drivers are concerned with your safety and meeting your schedule. They will be glad to answer any question you may have once the bus has come to a complete stop.

To signal a driver when you're on the bus, simply push the yellow signal strip on the pole near your seat. This will ring a bell to let the driver know to stop and let you off at the next corner or bus stop. Please exit through the rear door. All of our buses are ADA-accessible to persons with disabilities, and are equipped for wheelchairs.

Waco Transit has added a GPS tracking system to most of our routes. Download the free RideSystems app or visit the GPS website links for more information. You can now track your route on your smartphone, along with other helpful features.

Travel Training videos are available on our website on how to ride the bus, and how to use the GPS system on your phone and computer.

### **LOST AND FOUND**

Waco Transit maintains a Lost and Found service for a maximum of 7 days. If you have lost an item, call (254) 750-1613 for assistance. Unclaimed items will either be thrown away or donated.
