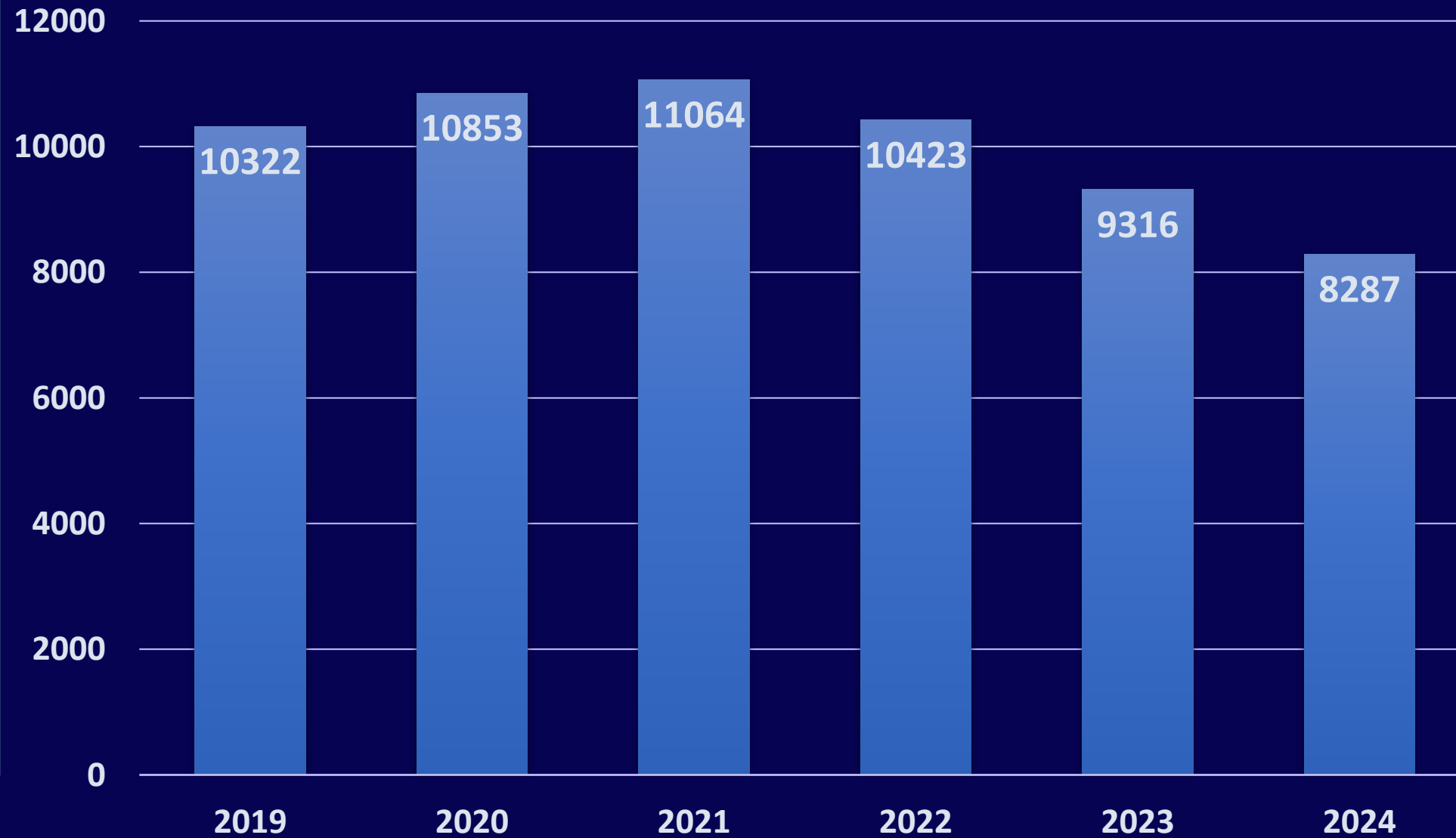

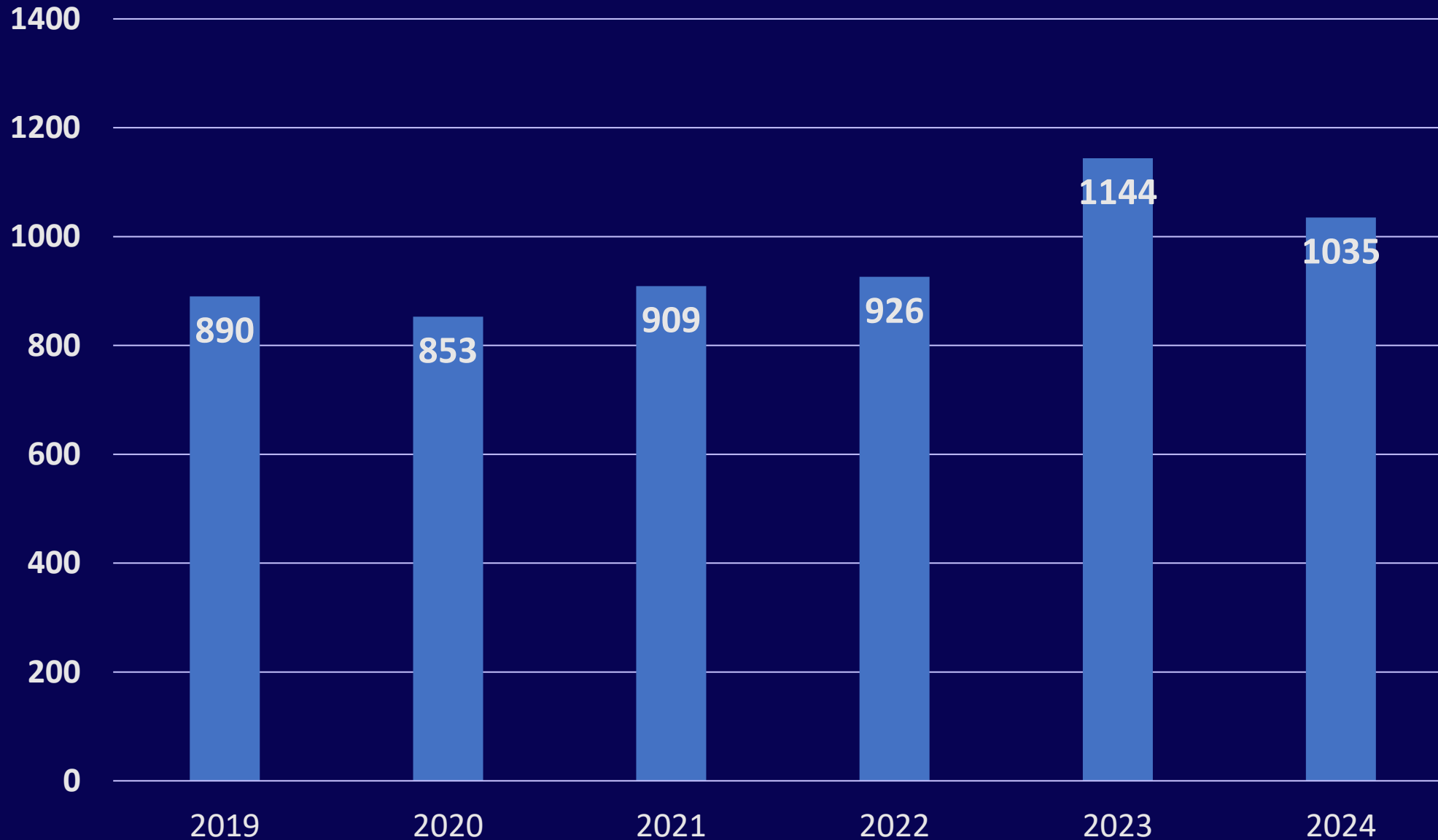

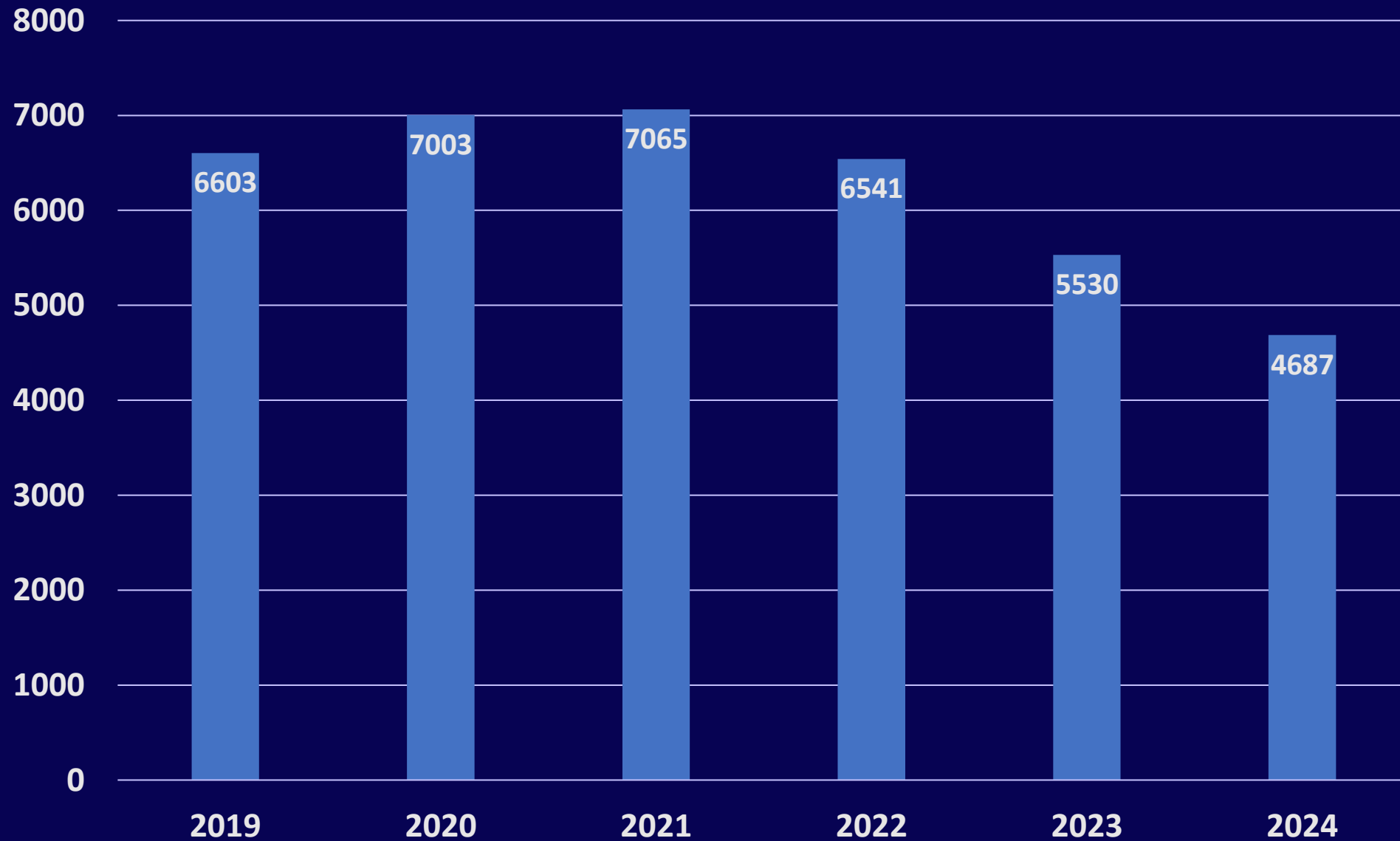

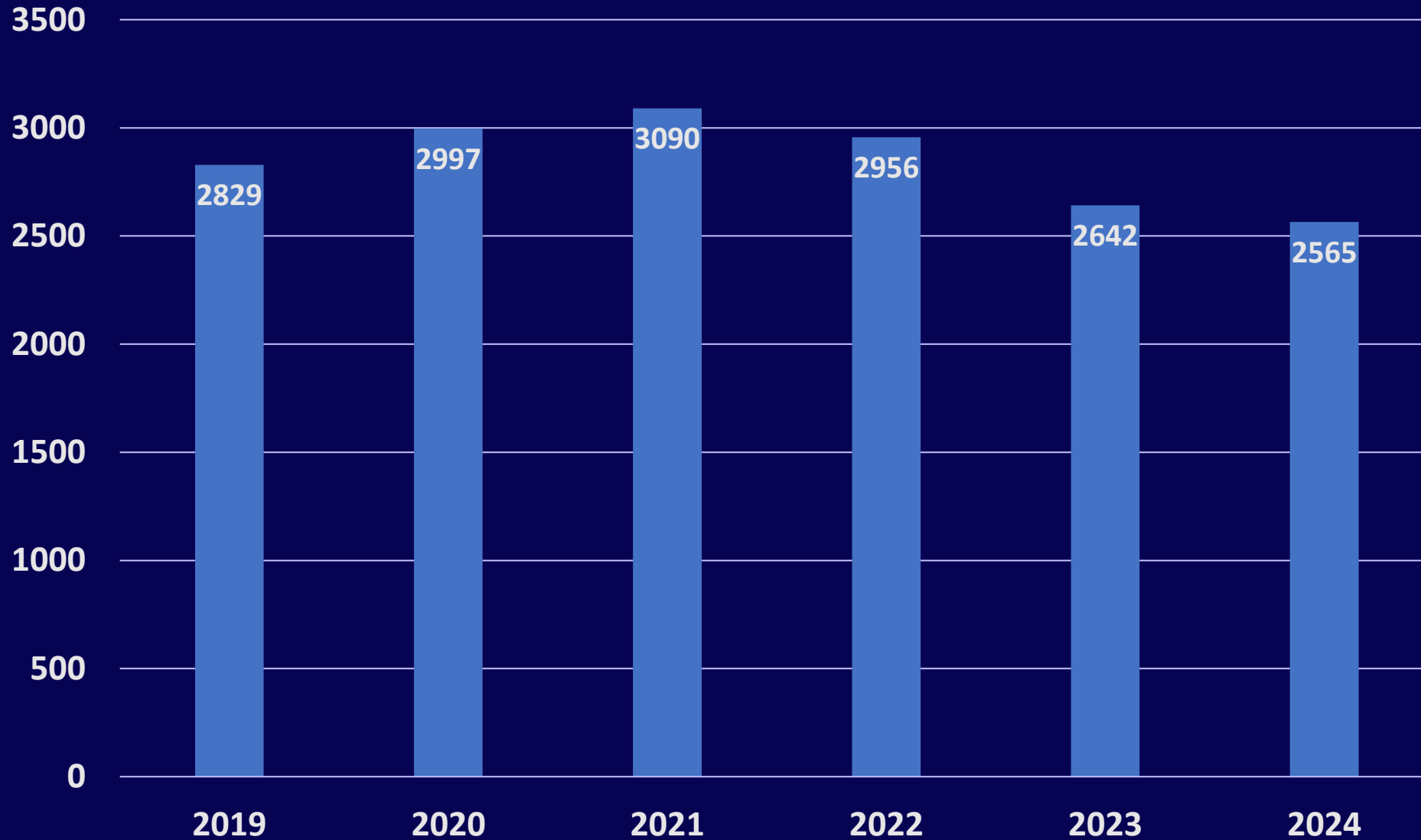

Homicide Chart



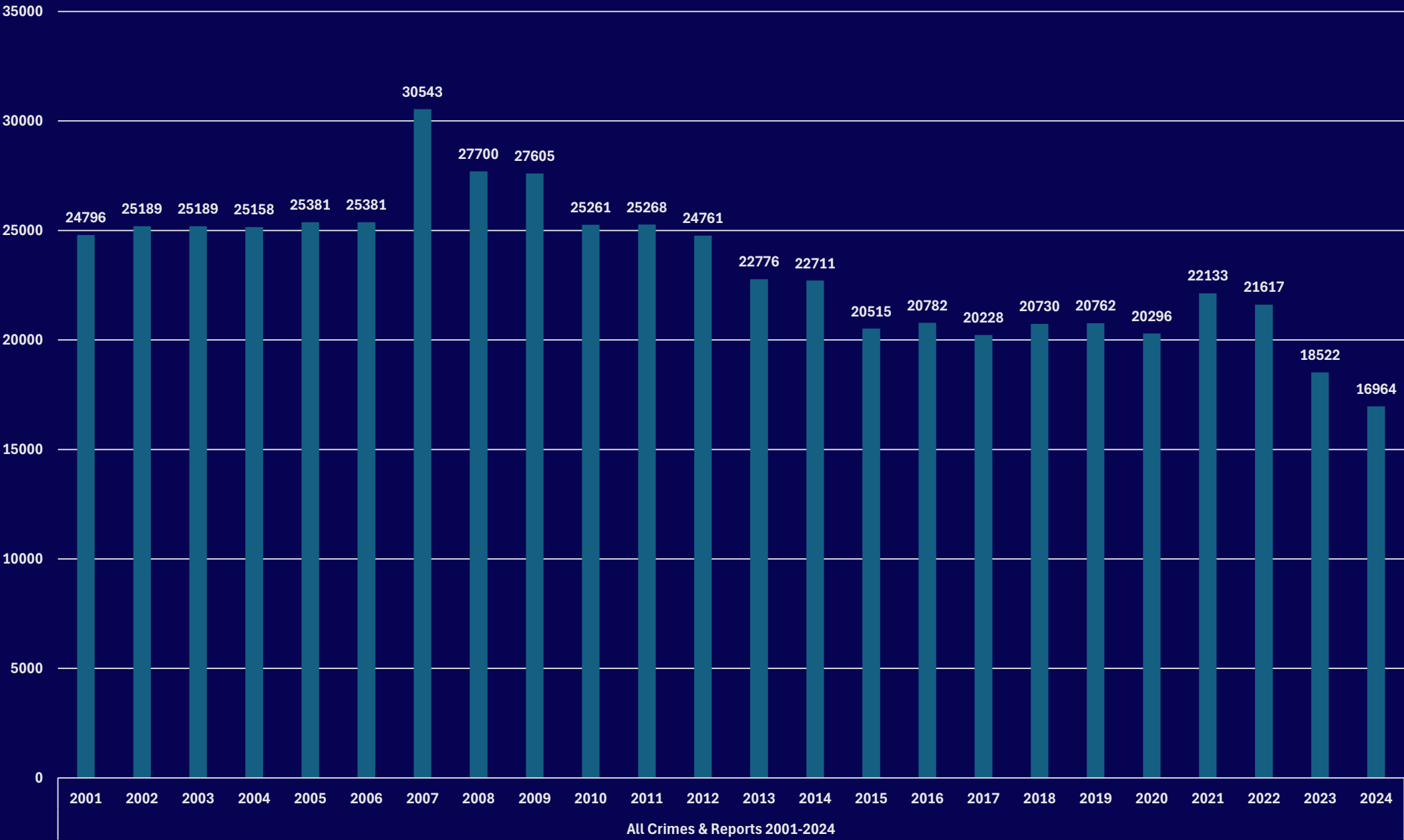

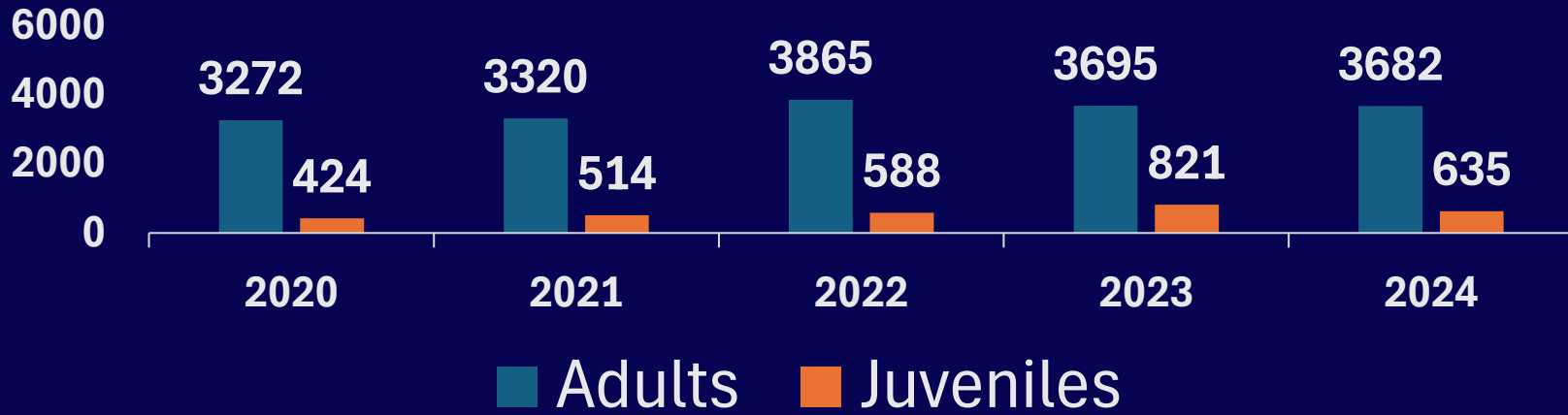

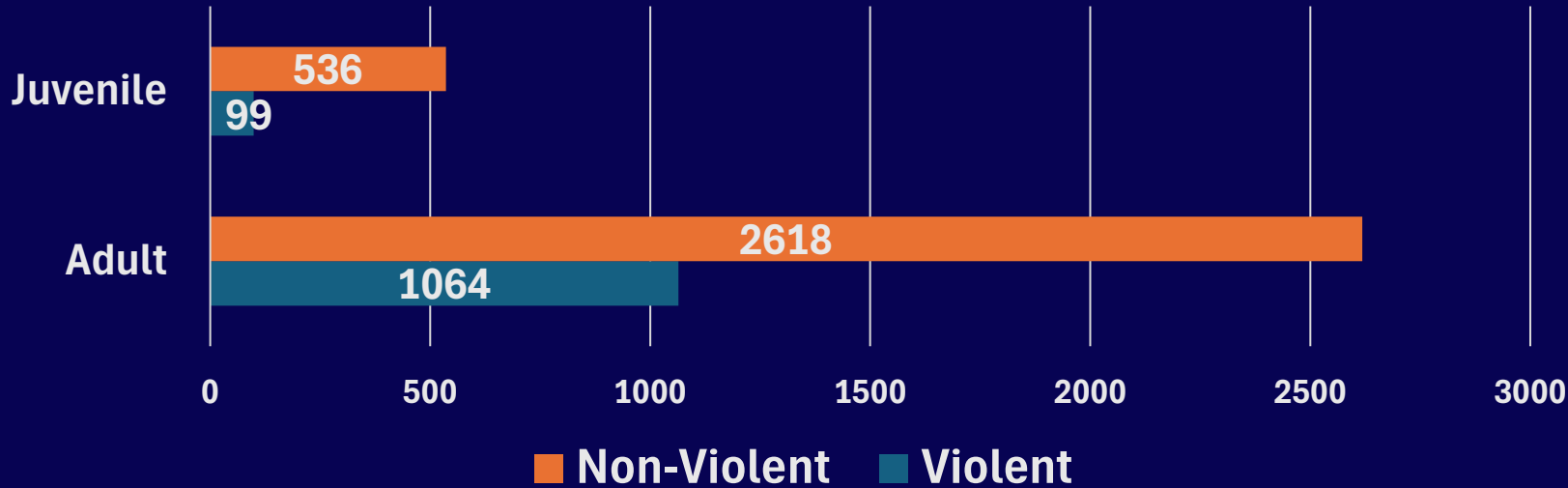
All Crimes 2001 -2024

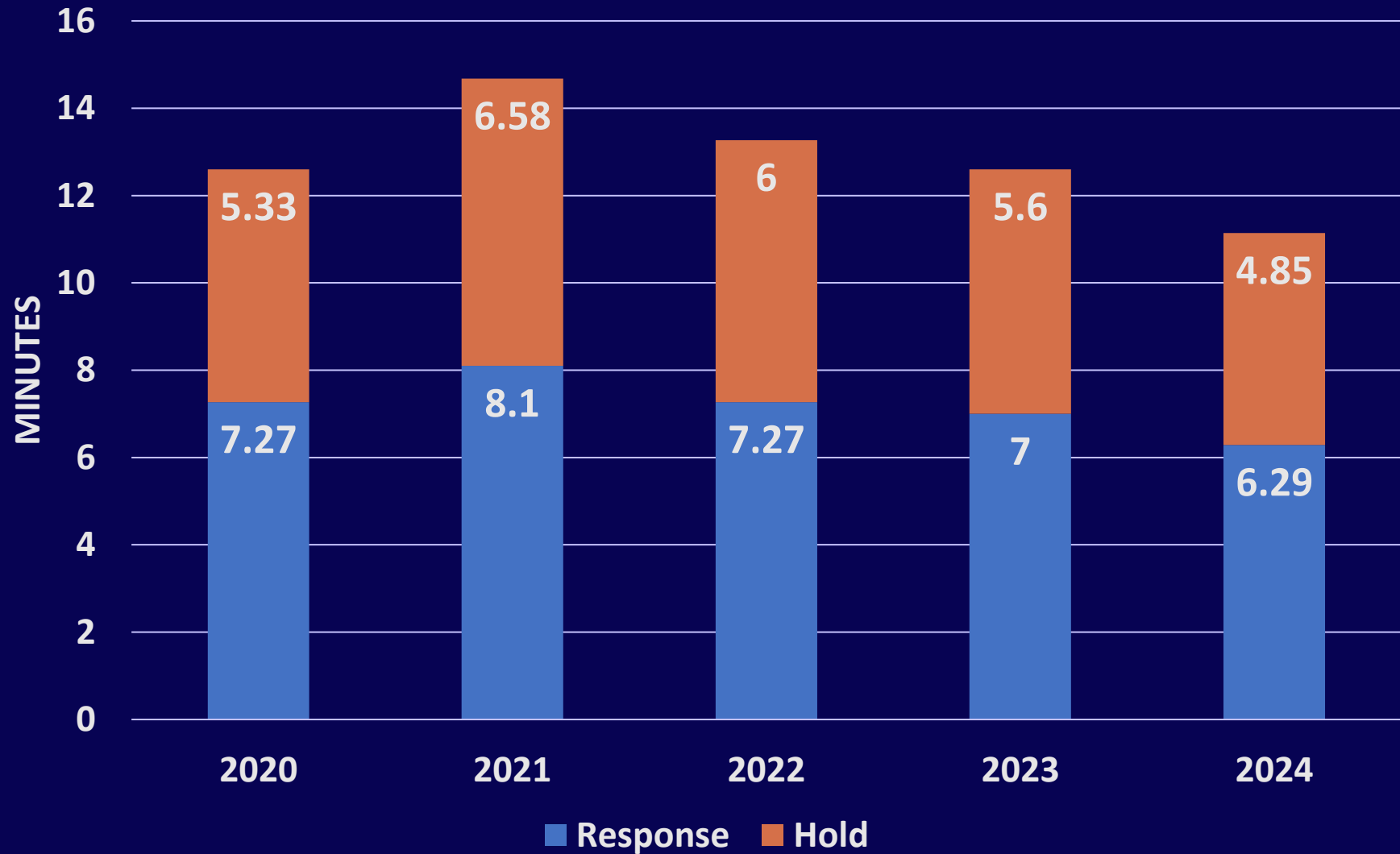

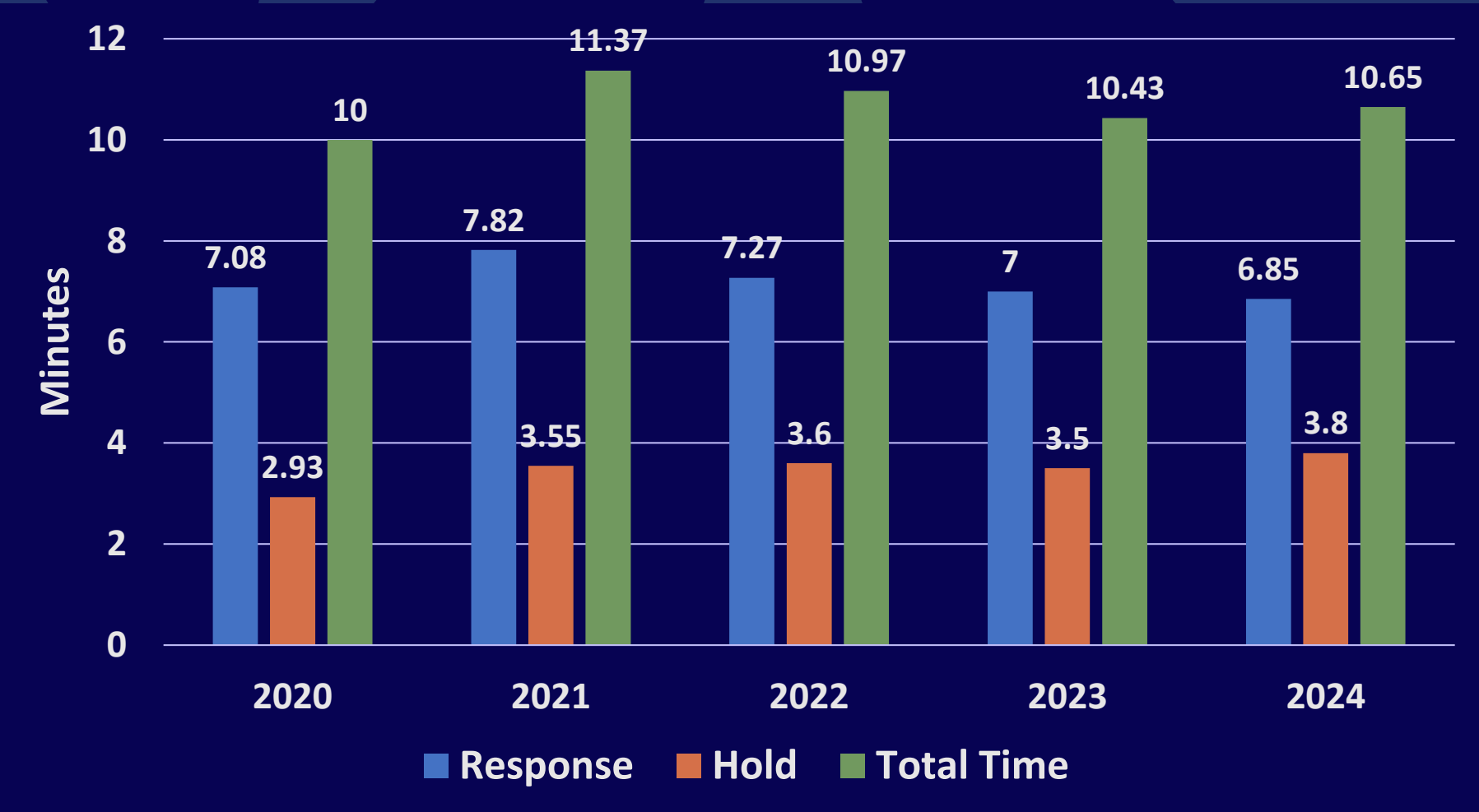


Dispatch Response & Hold Times All CFS





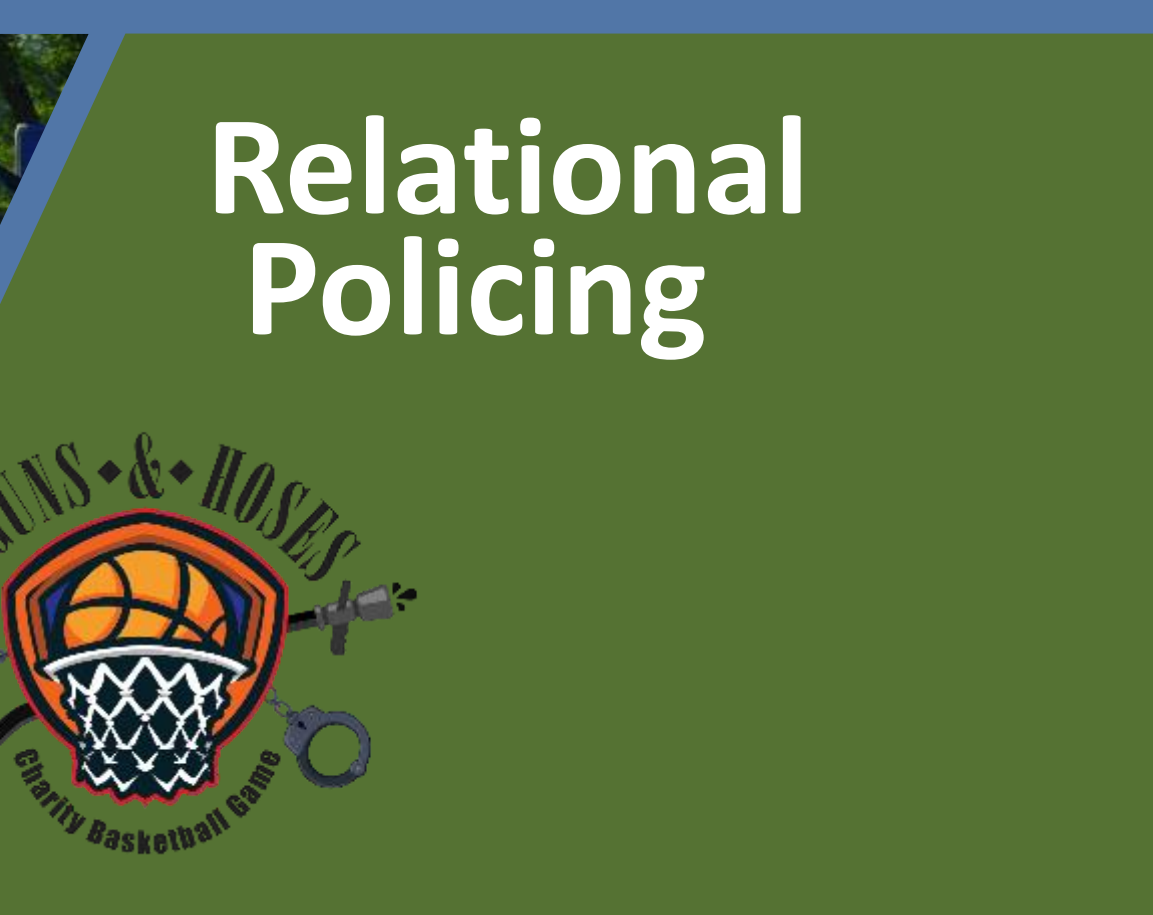
Dispatch Response & Hold Times Priority 1 CFS
