Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 467 New Cases of COVID-19 Four New Deaths Attributed to COVID-19 Free Testing Locations

(January 12, 2021) Four hundred and sixty-seven new cases of COVID-19 are cases are reported today, out of which 314 are new cases and 153 are previously unreported cases that are past their isolation period. The total number of cases to date is 21,296. There are 1,305 estimated active cases, and 19,676 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and eighty-one cases are hospitalized. Of the 181 hospitalized, 108 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty-three are on ventilators.

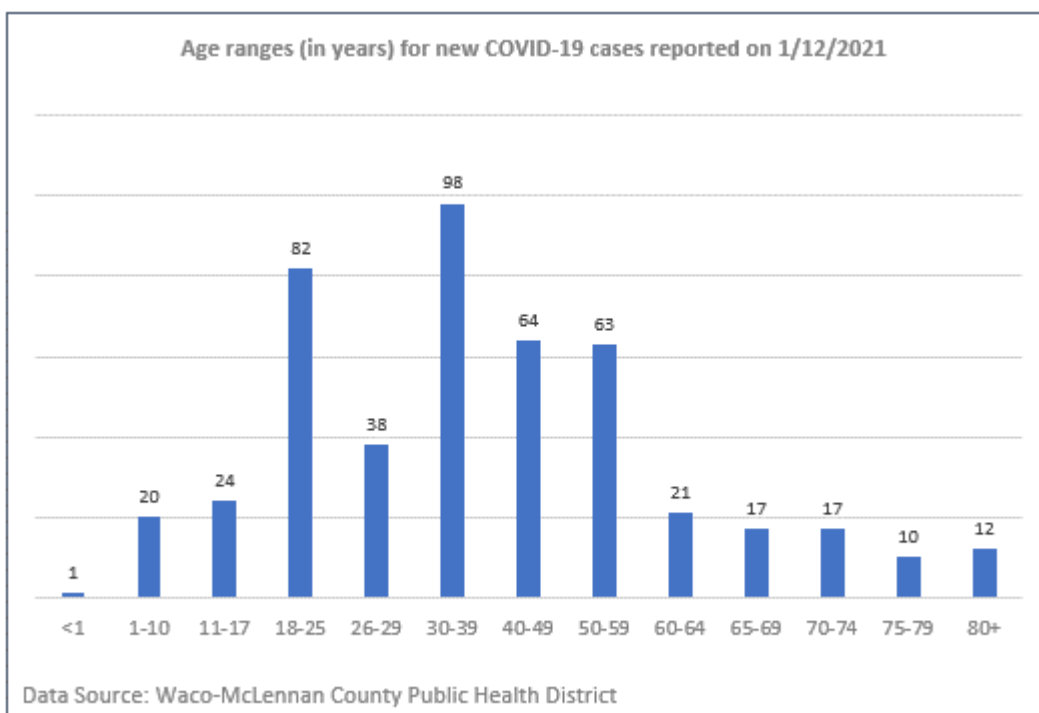
Sadly, four additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19 over the two days, bringing the total deaths to 315.

#312 was a 68-year-old white female.

#313 was a 56-year-old white male.

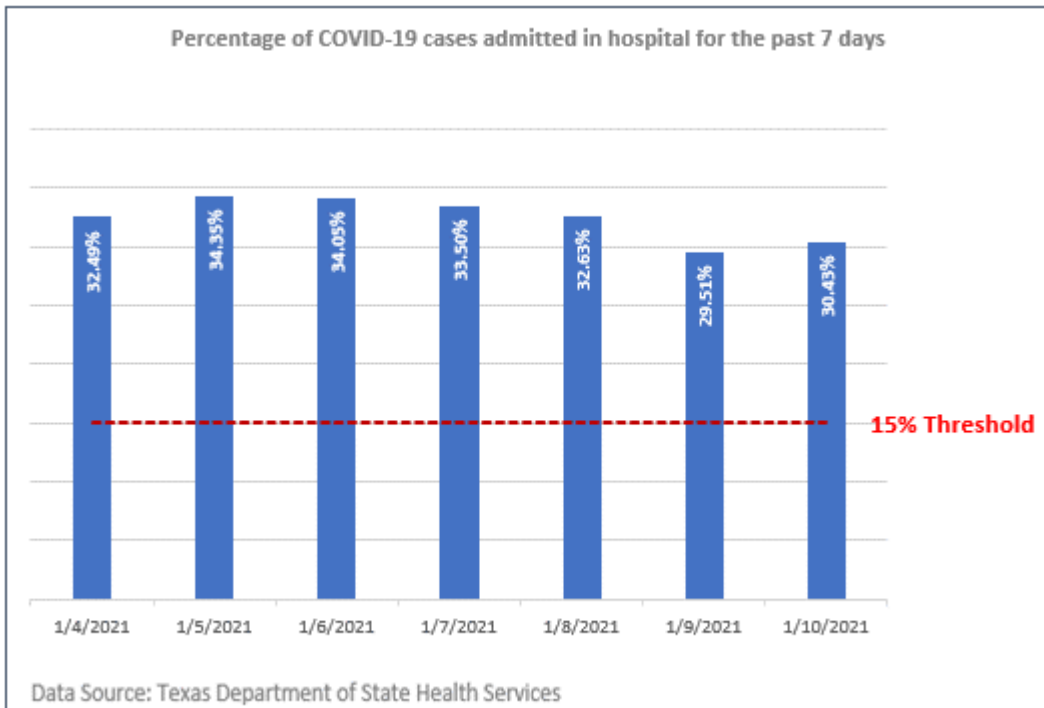
#314 was an 89-year-old white male.

#315 was a 108-year-old white female.



As of January 10, 2021, the hospitalization rate was 30.43% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.

Please note: As of Monday, 1/11/2021, the "Percentage of COVID-19 cases admitted in hospital for the past 7 days" graph will show a two-day lag. This change is in congruence with the reporting change on [the Texas Department of State Health Services website](#).



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
