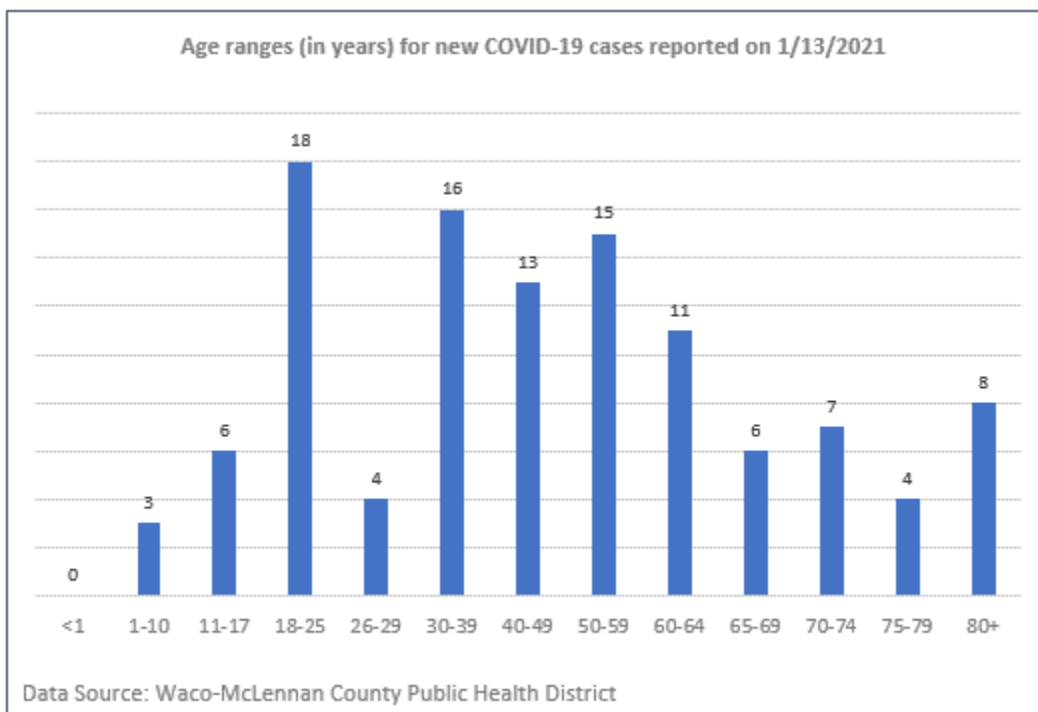

### Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 111 New Cases of COVID-19 No New Deaths Attributed to COVID-19 Free Testing Locations

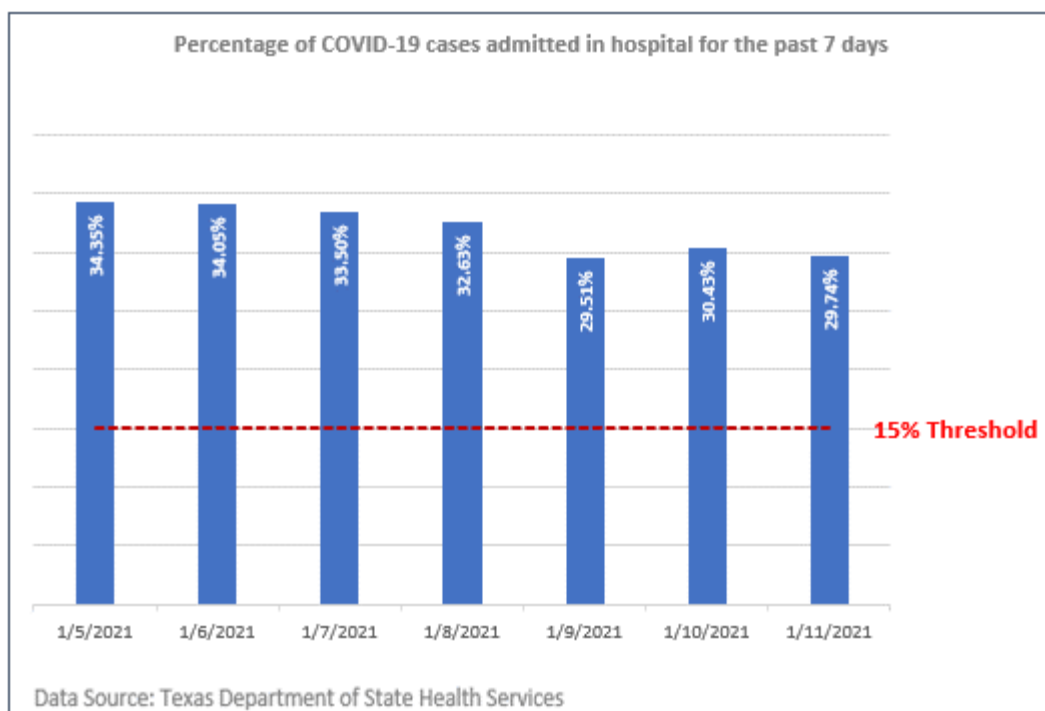
(January 13, 2021) One hundred and eleven new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. The total number of cases to date is 21,407. There are 1,303 estimated active cases, and 19,789 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and sixty-three are hospitalized. Of the 163 hospitalized, 107 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty-seven are on ventilators. There has been a total of 315 deaths in McLennan County.

As of January 11, 2021, the hospitalization rate was 29.74% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.

**Please note:** As of Monday, 1/11/2021, the "Percentage of COVID-19 cases admitted in hospital for the past 7 days" graph began showing a two-day lag. This change is in congruence with the reporting change on [the Texas Department of State Health Services website](#).



**Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:**

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
