Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 81 New Cases of COVID-19 Seven New Deaths Attributed to COVID-19 Free Testing Locations

(January 20, 2021) Eighty-one new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. The total number of cases to date is 22,373. There are 1,087 estimated active cases, and 20,949 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and thirty-nine are hospitalized. Of the 139 hospitalized, 90 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty-five are on ventilators.

Sadly, seven additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total deaths to 337.

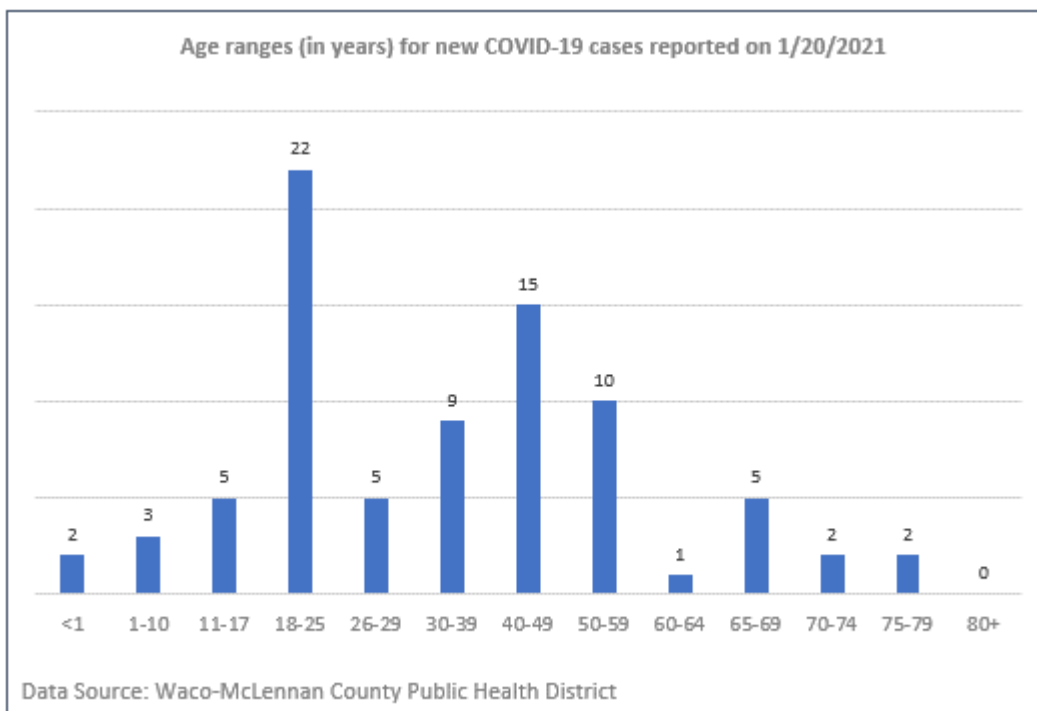

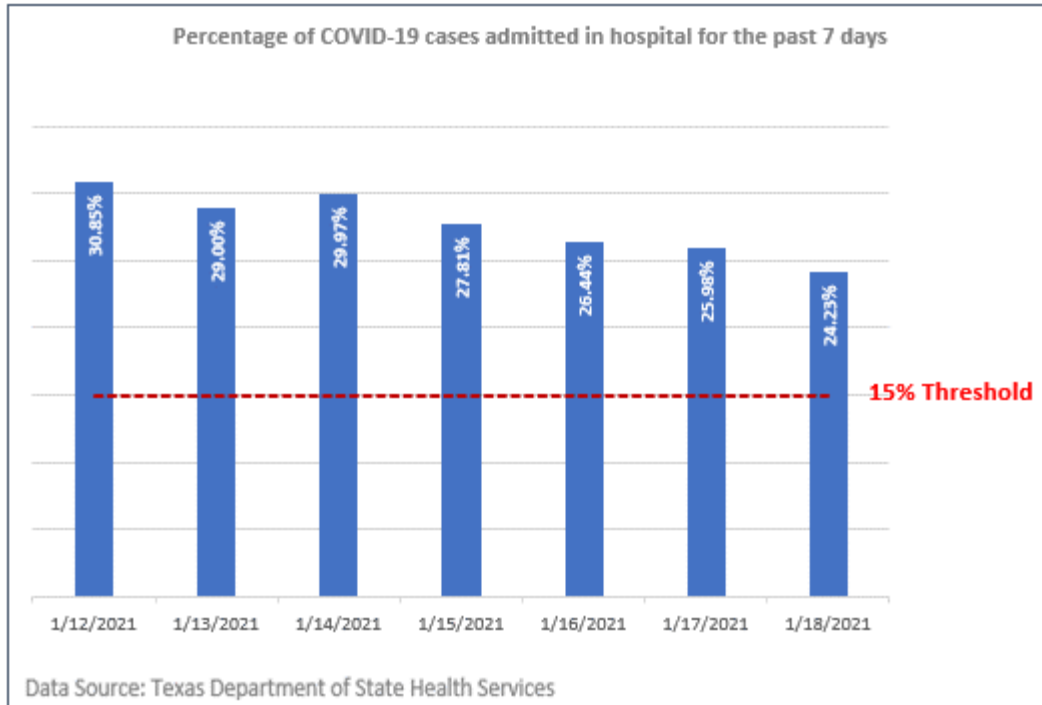

As of January 18, 2021, the hospitalization rate was 24.23% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.

Please note: The "Percentage of COVID-19 cases admitted in hospitals for the past 7 days" graph shows a two-day lag. This is in congruence with the reporting change on [the Texas Department of State Health Services website](#).



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
