The Waco Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is now receiving public comment on proposed roadway safety and public transportation asset condition performance targets for calendar year 2020.

Transportation Performance Management (TPM) is federally required by Congress through the FAST Act. It is a strategic approach that uses goals, measures, and data to make better informed decisions about how to invest transportation funding aimed at a better performing national transportation system. The Waco MPO is proposing to support safety targets established by the Texas Department of Transportation and to adopt public transportation asset condition targets established by Waco Transit System, Inc. in accordance with these requirements and is soliciting public comment regarding them.

The MPO will be conducting 2 public informational meetings to give interested persons the opportunity to view the draft recommendations and to solicit comments regarding these recommendations. The meetings are scheduled as follows:
