A Portion of Franklin Avenue Will be Closed on Saturday

WACO, TX (October 15, 2020) – Waco ISD’s contractor Jacobs-Cathey Company will be using a crane to replace air conditioning units on the roof of the Waco ISD Administration building on Saturday, October 17 from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The crane will be placed on Franklin Avenue; therefore, Franklin Avenue will be closed at S. 6th Street to S. 5th Street to accommodate the crane. Traffic will be directed to turn right onto 6th Street or follow a marked detour route via Austin Avenue to travel around the single block closure.

Drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly and find an alternate route for those traveling in the area during this time to minimize delays and traffic congestion.

Safety is a top priority at City of Waco, when driving through a work zone, some simple steps to take are: slow down, pay attention, avoid distractions such as cell phones, be patient and plan ahead.
