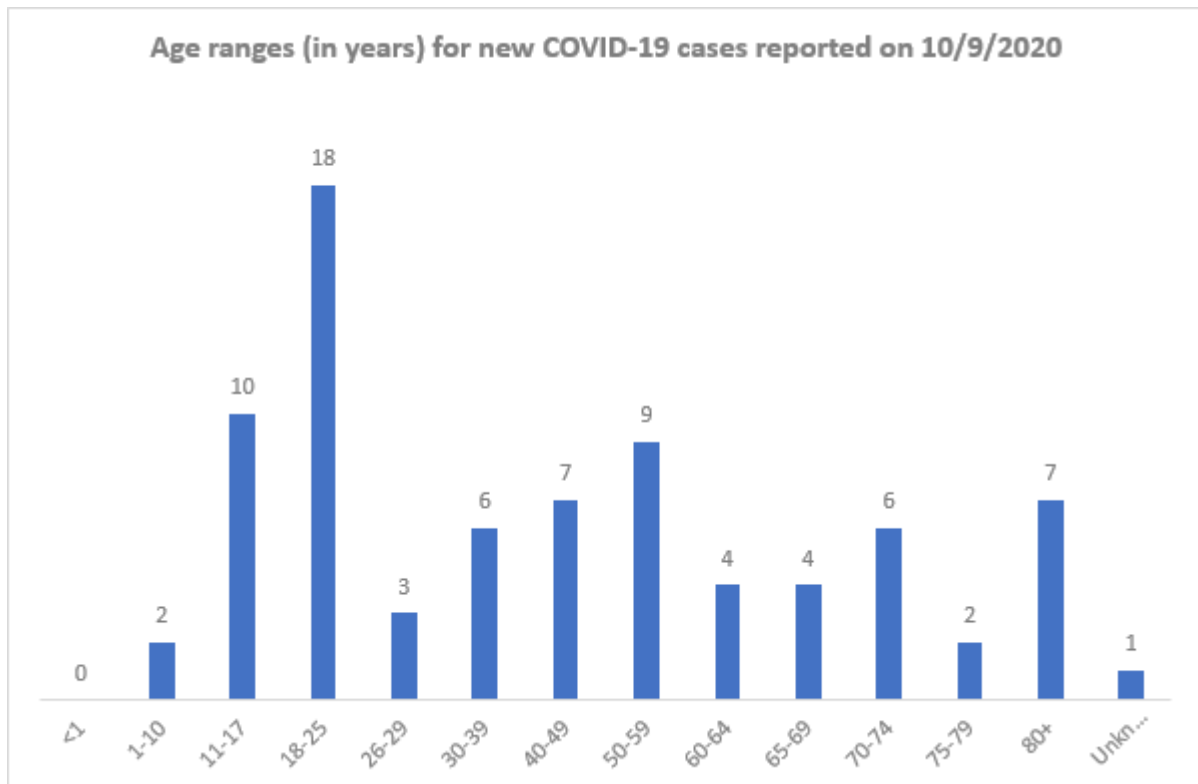

- **79 New Cases of COVID-19**
- **One additional death due to COVID-19**
- **Next TWO days free testing locations**

(October 9, 2020) Seventy-nine new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. The total number of cases to date is 8,879. There are 503 estimated active cases, and 8,252 estimated cases who have recovered. Fifty-three cases are hospitalized. Of the 53 hospitalized, 41 cases are McLennan County residents. Seven cases are on ventilators. Sadly, one additional death has been recorded. There has been a total of 124 deaths in McLennan County.

#124 was a 78-year-old white female.
