## **S. 26th Street To Be Closed Next Week for Work**

**WACO, TX (October 9, 2020)** – A contractor will close the intersection of S. 26th Street and Ross Ave. beginning Monday, October 12 at 8 a.m. and ending Tuesday, October 13 at 6 p.m. for a water main tie in. Detour will be in place.

Drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly and find an alternate route for those traveling in the area during this time to minimize delays and traffic congestion.
