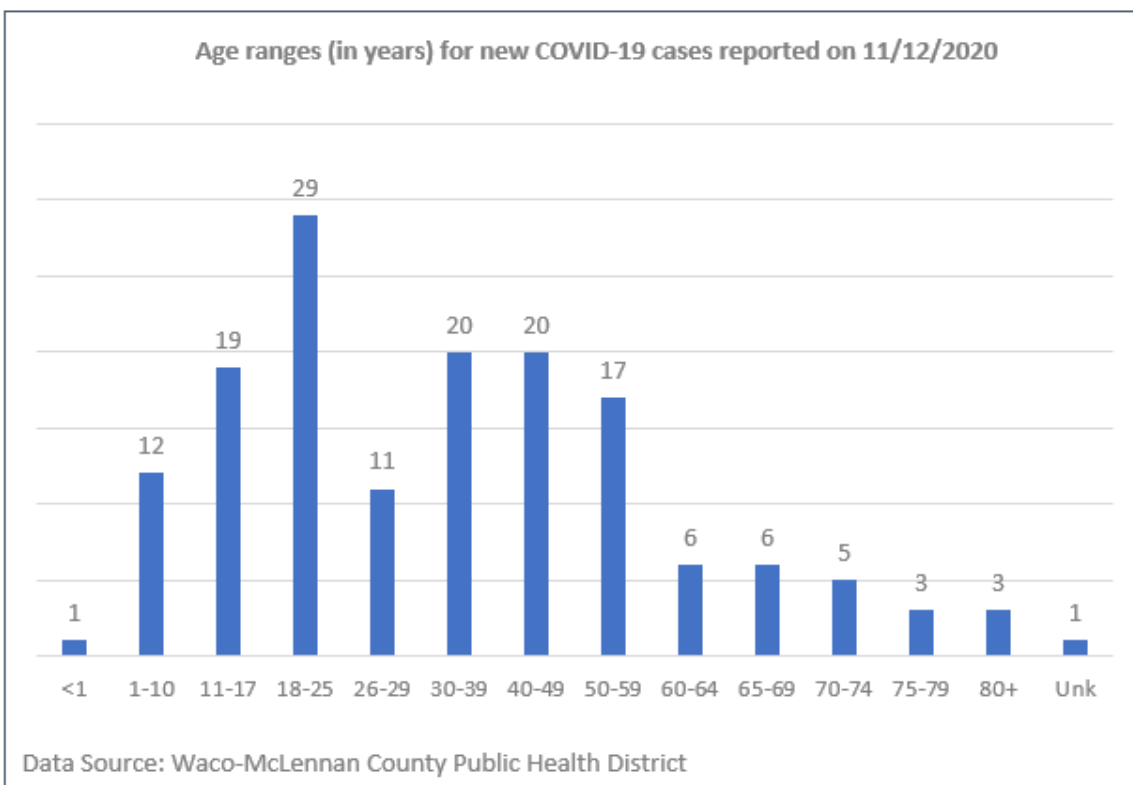
- 153 New Cases of COVID-19
- 3 Deaths Attributed to COVID-19
- Next TWO days free testing locations

(November 12, 2020) One hundred and fifty-three new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Fifty-one of the cases are reported from surge testing. The total number of cases to date is 11,778. There are 1,071 estimated active cases, and 10,539 estimated cases who have recovered. Seventy-two cases are hospitalized. Of the 72 hospitalized, 52 cases are McLennan County residents. Twelve are on ventilators. Sadly, three additional deaths have been reported due to COVID-19. The total number of deaths is 168.

#166 was a 78-year-old white female.

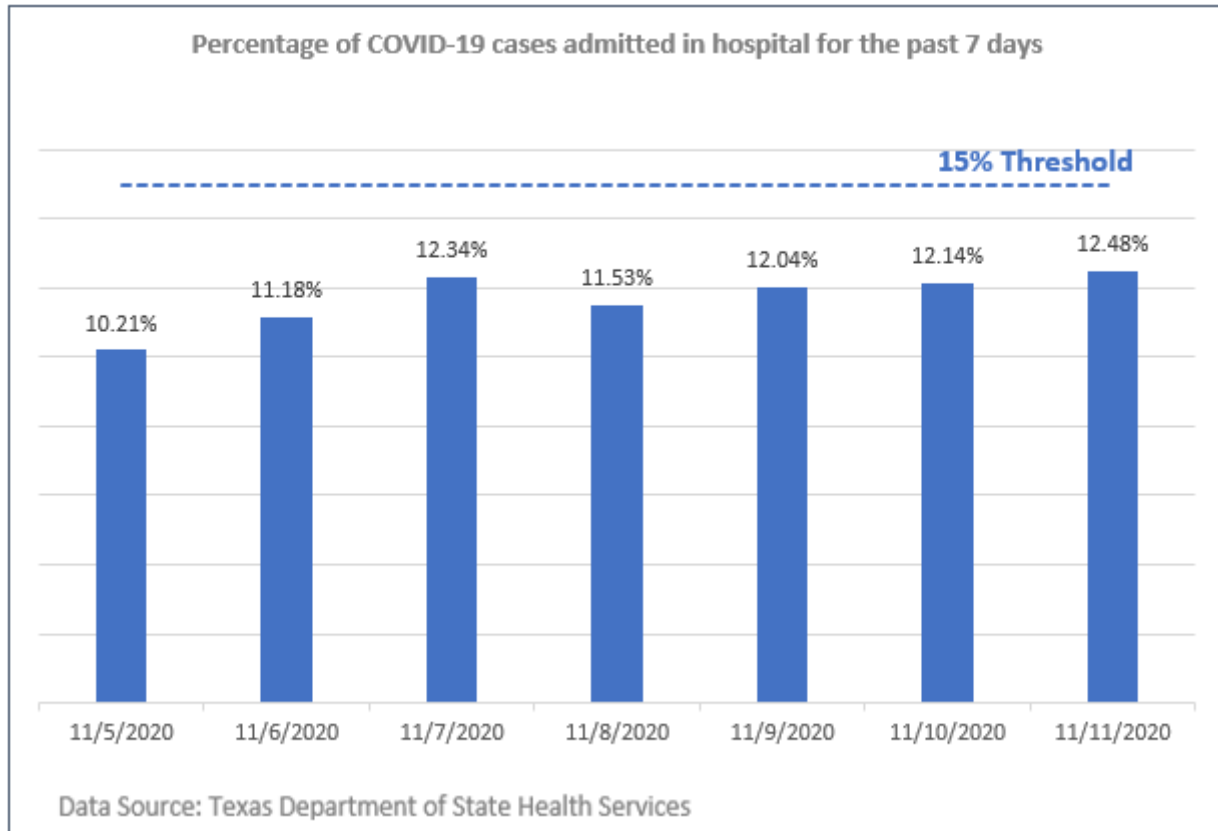
#167 was a 69-year-old Hispanic male.

As of November 11, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 12.48% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS).



Executive Order GA-32 allows restaurants and other venues to reopen at 75% capacity and allows elective surgeries if the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate under 15% over a seven-day period. If the hospitalization rate goes over 15% for seven consecutive days, venue capacity will be lowered to 50% and elective surgeries will be postponed until further notice.
