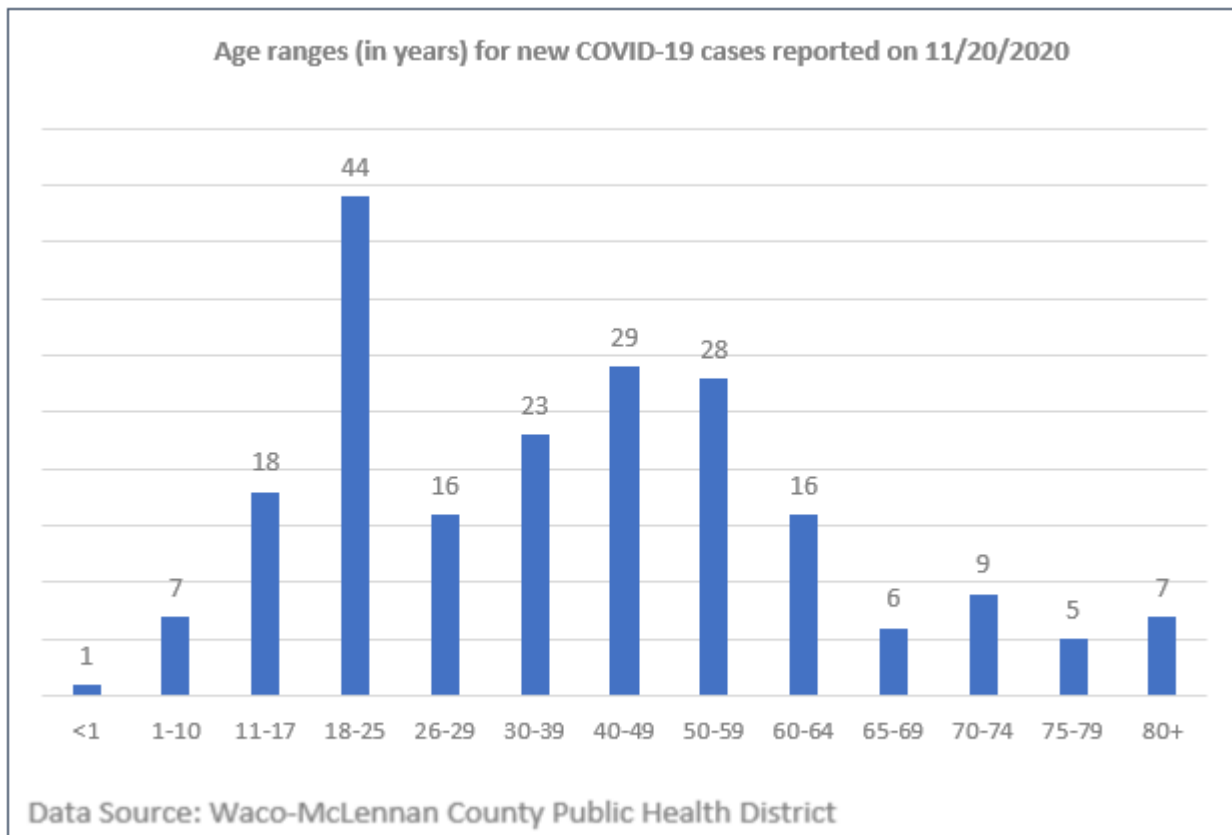
Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces

- 209 New Cases of COVID-19
- Two Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19
 - Next TWO days free testing locations

(November 20, 2020) Two hundred and nine new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Eighty-six of the cases are reported from surge testing. The total number of cases to date is 13,156. There are 1,369 estimated active cases, and 11,611 estimated cases who have recovered. Eighty-seven are hospitalized. Of the 87 hospitalized, 64 cases are McLennan County residents. Thirteen are on ventilators. Sadly, two additional deaths have been reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total of deaths to 176.

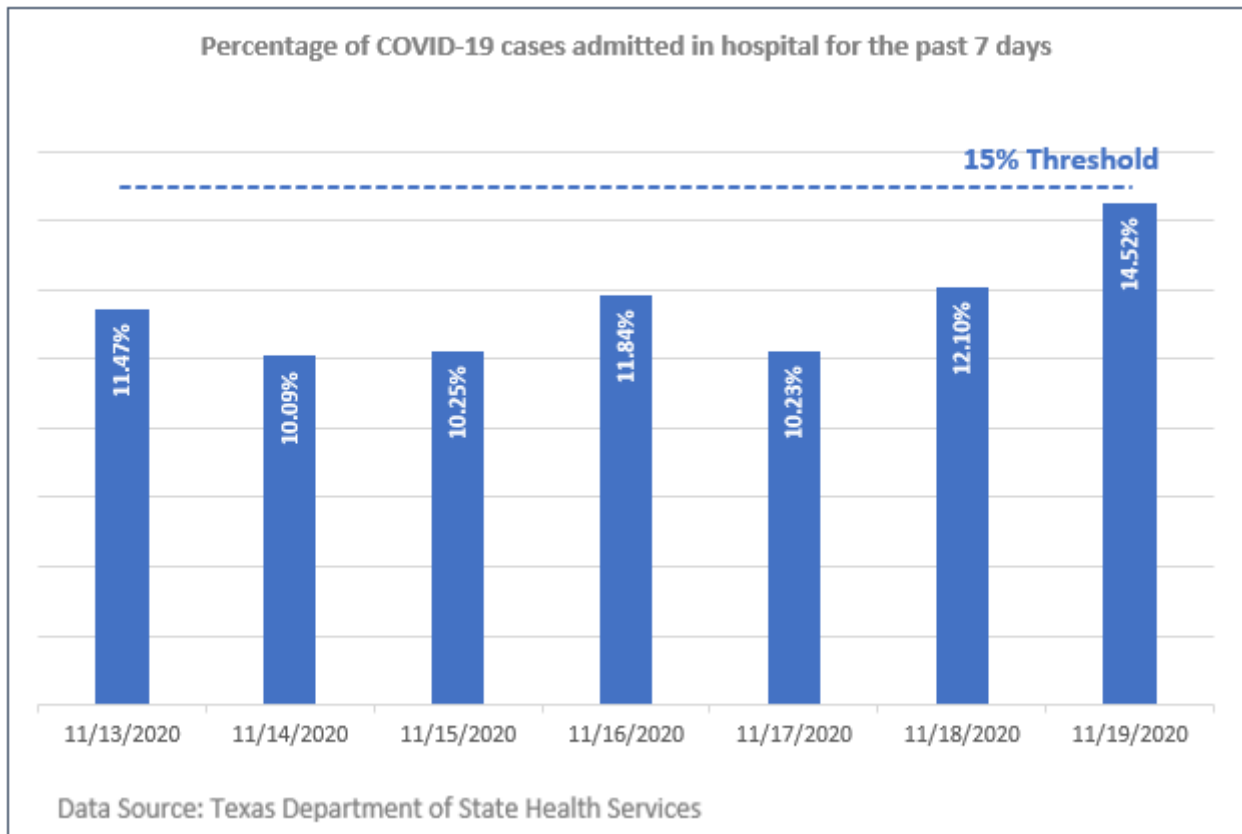

As of November 19, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 14.52% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS).



Executive Order GA-32 allows restaurants and other venues to reopen at 75% capacity and allows elective surgeries if the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Area (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% over a seven-day period. If the hospitalization rate goes over 15% for seven consecutive days, venue capacity will be lowered to 50% and elective surgeries will be postponed until further notice.
