- **COVID-19 Statistics from Nov 26th – 30th**
- **12 Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19**
- **Next TWO days free testing locations**

(November 30, 2020) Due to the fact that the Health District did not report COVID-19 statistics over the Thanksgiving Holidays, the information is broken out for each day as shown below.

Thursday, November 26, 2020: One hundred and forty-six new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed for this date. Eighty-eight of those cases were reported from surge testing. The total number of cases as of this date is 14,175. There were 1,372 active cases and 12,618 estimated recovered cases as of this date. There were 93 hospitalized patients, and of these, 66 were McLennan County residents. Fifteen were on ventilators.

Friday, November 27, 2020: Forty-two new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed for this date. No new cases were reported from surge testing. The total number of cases as of this date is 14,217. There were 1,215 active cases and 12,816 estimated recovered cases as of this date. There were 93 hospitalized patients, and of these, 67 were McLennan County residents. Seventeen were on ventilators.

Saturday, November 28, 2020: Eighty-nine new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed for this date. Forty-four of those cases were reported from surge testing. The total number of cases as of this date is 14,306. There were 1,102 active cases and 13,017 estimated recovered cases as of this date. There were 96 hospitalized patients, and of these, 69 were McLennan County residents. Seventeen were on ventilators.

Sunday, November 29, 2020: Forty-eight new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed for this date. No new cases were reported from surge testing. The total number of cases as of this date is 14,354. There were 937 active cases and 13,228 estimated recovered cases as of this date. There were 93 hospitalized patients, and of these, 67 were McLennan County residents. Nineteen were on ventilators.

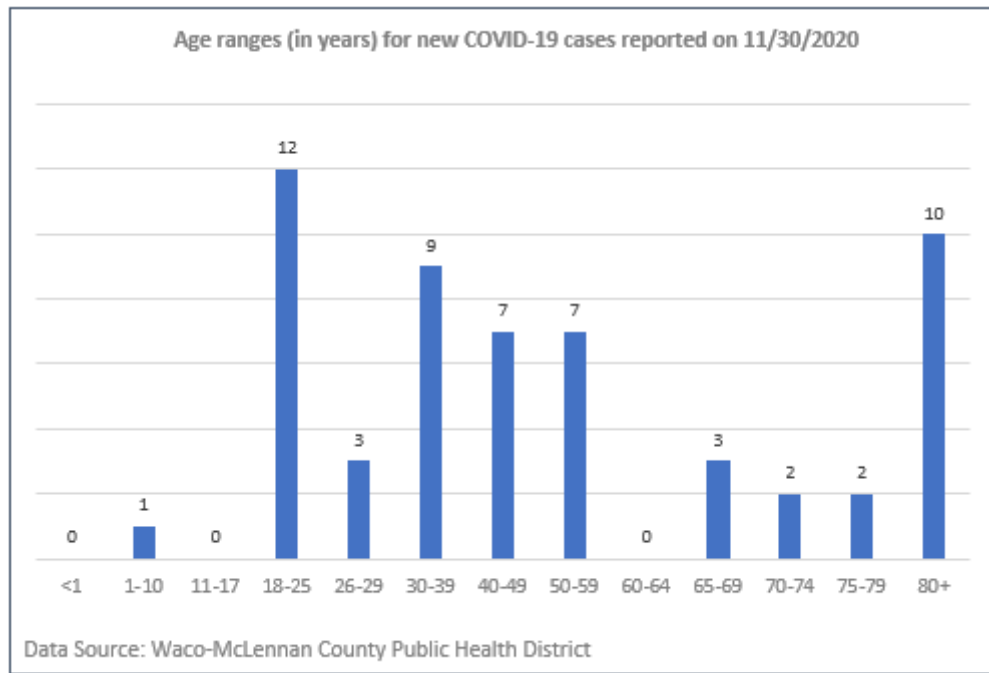
Monday, November 30, 2020: Fifty-six new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. No new cases were reported from surge testing. The total number of cases to date is 14,410. There are 793 estimated active cases, and 13,420 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and one cases are hospitalized. Of the 101 hospitalized, 66 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty-two are on ventilators.

Sadly, 12 additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19 over the holiday, bringing the total deaths to 197.

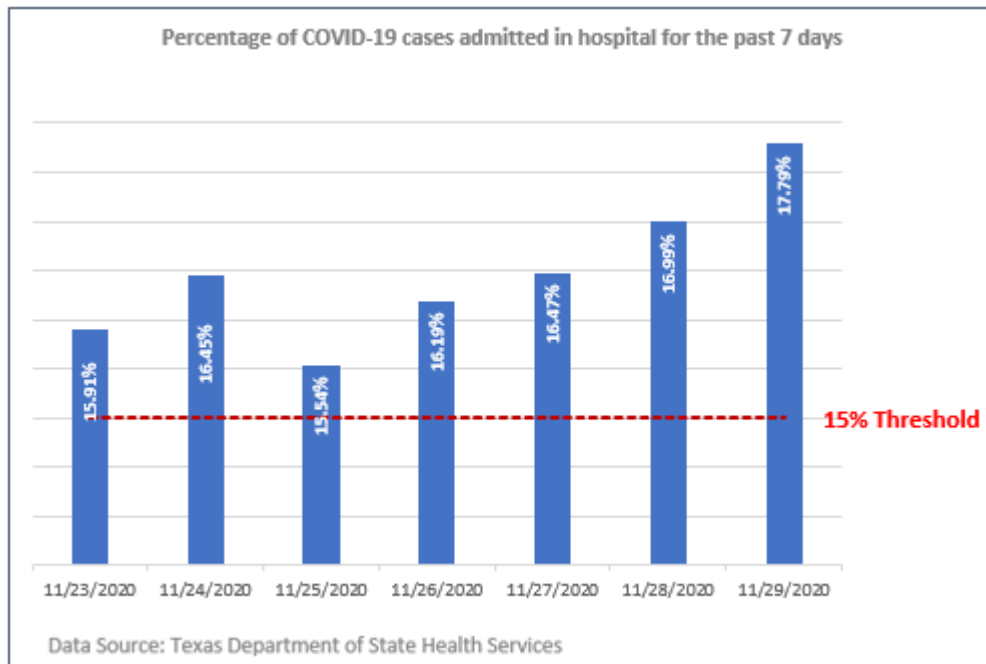

As of November 29, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 17.79% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
