City of Waco General and Special Election Returns

(Waco, Texas November 4, 2020) The City of Waco General and Special Election was held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. The City of Waco Charter provides that the qualified person receiving the highest number of votes cast for any office will be declared by the council, elected (plurality). Final Unofficial Tabulation returns are:

Waco Mayor: Dillon Meek (two-year term)

Dillon Meek	22,589 Votes	(68.95%)
David Morrow	10,174 Votes	(31.05%)

City Council District I: Andrea J. Barefield (two-year term)

Randy Gober	1,273 Votes	(28.52%)
Andrea J. Barefield	3,190 Votes	(71.48%)

City Council District III: Josh Borderud (two-year term)

Josh Borderud	4,044 Votes	(51.41%)
Aubrey "Robbie" Robertson	3,822 Votes	(48.59%)

City Council District IV: Kelly Palmer (uncompleted term)

Darius Ewing	1,303 Votes	(31.29 %)
Kelly Palmer	1,952 Votes	(46.88%)
Rick Allen	909 Votes	(21.83 %)

Kelly Palmer will serve the uncompleted term for District IV ending May 2021 which was left by Dillon Meek when he had to step down because he moved out of district IV. The next general election for City Council Districts II, IV and V will be held on May 1, 2021.

Mayor Deaver and Council Members Kinnaird and Ewing will continue to serve until November 17, 2020. The official canvassing of election results and the swearing in of elected City Council members will be conducted after the November 17, 2020, City Council Business Session. The ceremony will be closed to the public but will be broadcast live on wccc.tv.
