Two-Way Conversion Planned for Washington Ave.

Public Meeting on Tuesday, Nov. 13

WACO, TEXAS (November 8, 2018) – A public meeting in an open house format is scheduled for Tuesday, November 13, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. at the Waco-McLennan County Central Library (1717 Austin Ave., Waco, TX) regarding the Washington Avenue two-way conversion project. Construction is estimated to begin 2019.

The meeting will give citizens the opportunity to review the current engineering design, traffic models and other information regarding the conversion of Washington Avenue to two-way operation. Representatives from the City of Waco will be available to answer any questions about the proposed project.

This project is part of the City's ongoing street Pavement Management Program to improve streets. This project is a collaborative effort of the Public Works Department and Water Utilities Department.

Safety is a top priority at City of Waco, when driving through a work zone, some simple steps to take are: slow down, pay attention, avoid distractions such as cell phones, be patient and plan ahead.
