- **Next TWO days free testing locations**

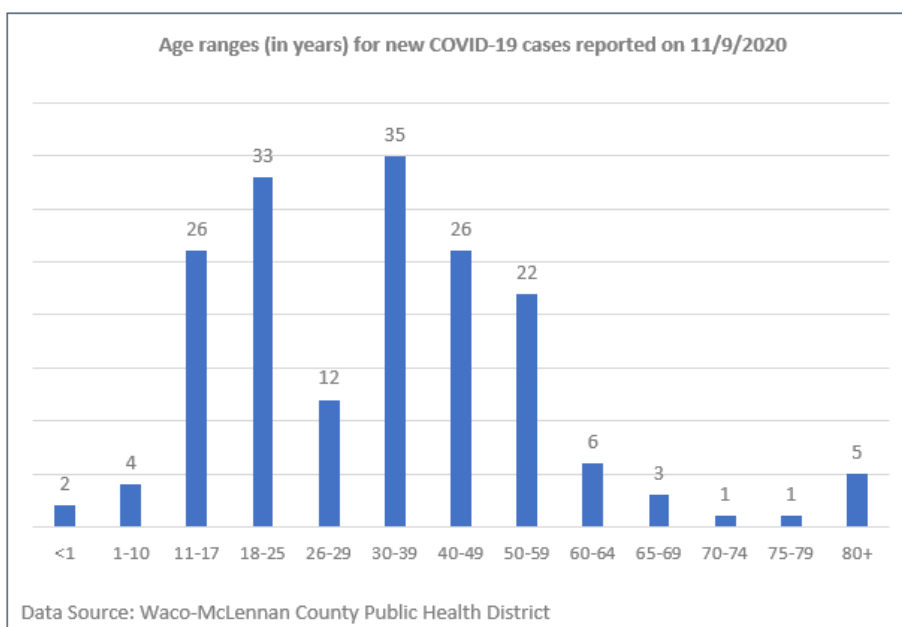
(November 9, 2020) Due to the fact that the Health District does not report COVID-19 statistics on Sunday, we break out Sunday and Monday as shown below.

Sunday, November 8, 2020: Eighty-nine new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed for this date. Sixty-one cases were reported from surge testing. There were 816 active cases and 10,203 estimated recovered cases as of this date. There were 68 hospitalized patients, and of these, 53 were McLennan County residents.

Monday, November 9, 2020: One hundred and seven new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. No new cases reported from surge testing. The total number of cases to date is 11,289. There are 829 estimated active cases, and 10,296 estimated cases who have recovered. 72 cases are hospitalized. Of the 72 hospitalized, 54 cases are McLennan County residents. 11 are on ventilators. Sadly, two additional deaths have been reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total of deaths to 164.

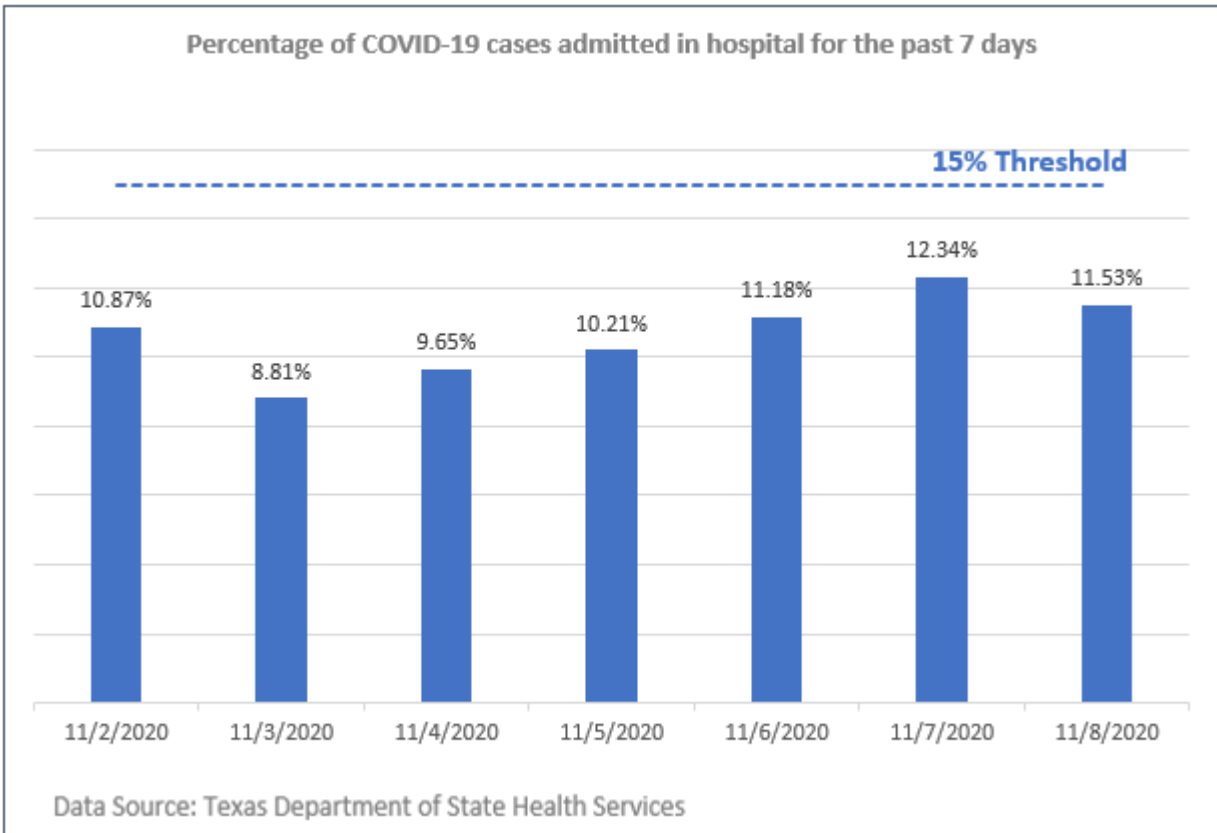
#163 was an 87-year-old white female.
