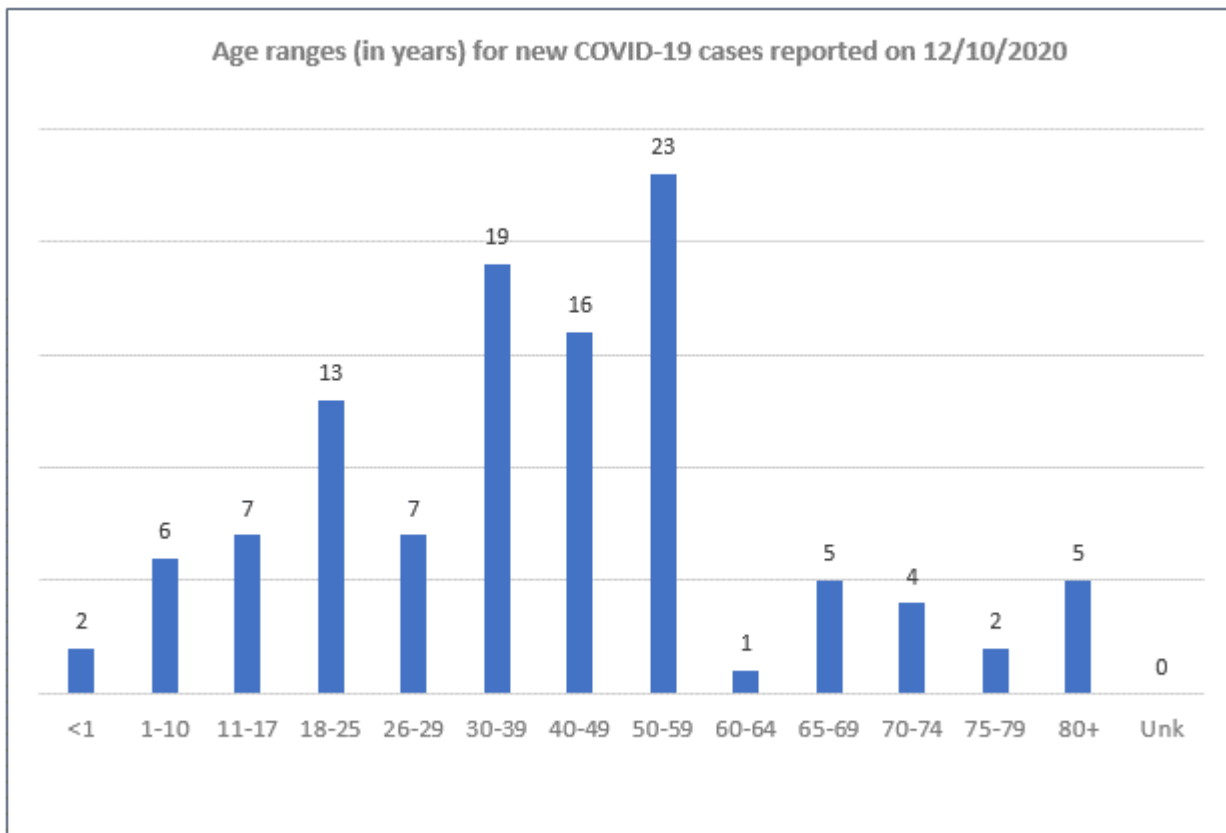
Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 110 New Cases of COVID-19 2 Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19 Next TWO Days Free Testing Locations

(December 10, 2020) One hundred ten new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Thirteen cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 15,990. There are 1,147 estimated active cases, and 14,614 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and four cases are hospitalized. Of the 104 hospitalized, 70 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty-one are on ventilators.

Sadly, two additional deaths were reported due to COVID-1, bringing the total deaths to 229.

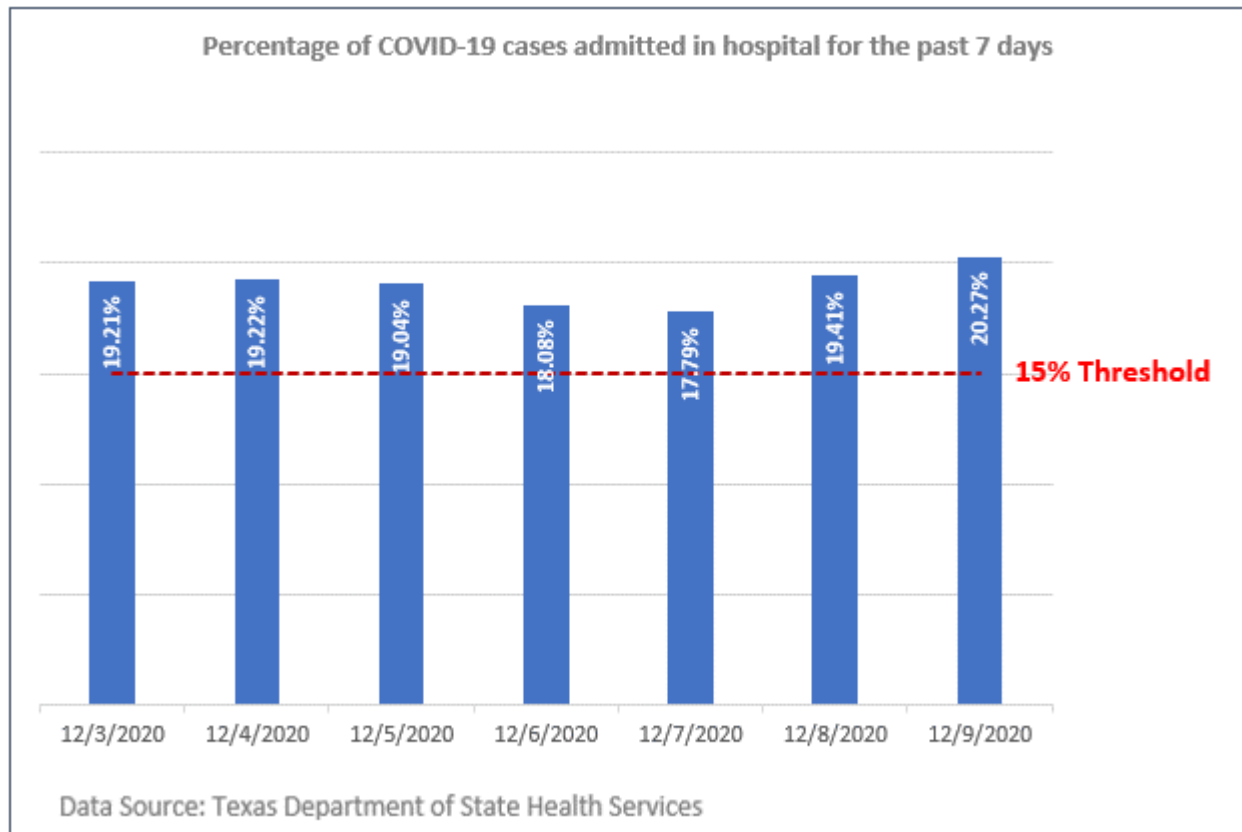
#228 was a 92-year-old white female.

As of December 9, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 20.27% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
