**137 New Cases of COVID-19**

**4 Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19**

**Free Testing Locations for Dec 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>**

(December 11, 2020) One hundred and thirty-seven new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Fifteen cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 16,127. There are 1,002 estimated active cases, and 14,892 estimated cases who have recovered. Ninety-nine cases are hospitalized. Of the 99 hospitalized, 68 cases are McLennan County residents. Thirteen are on ventilators.

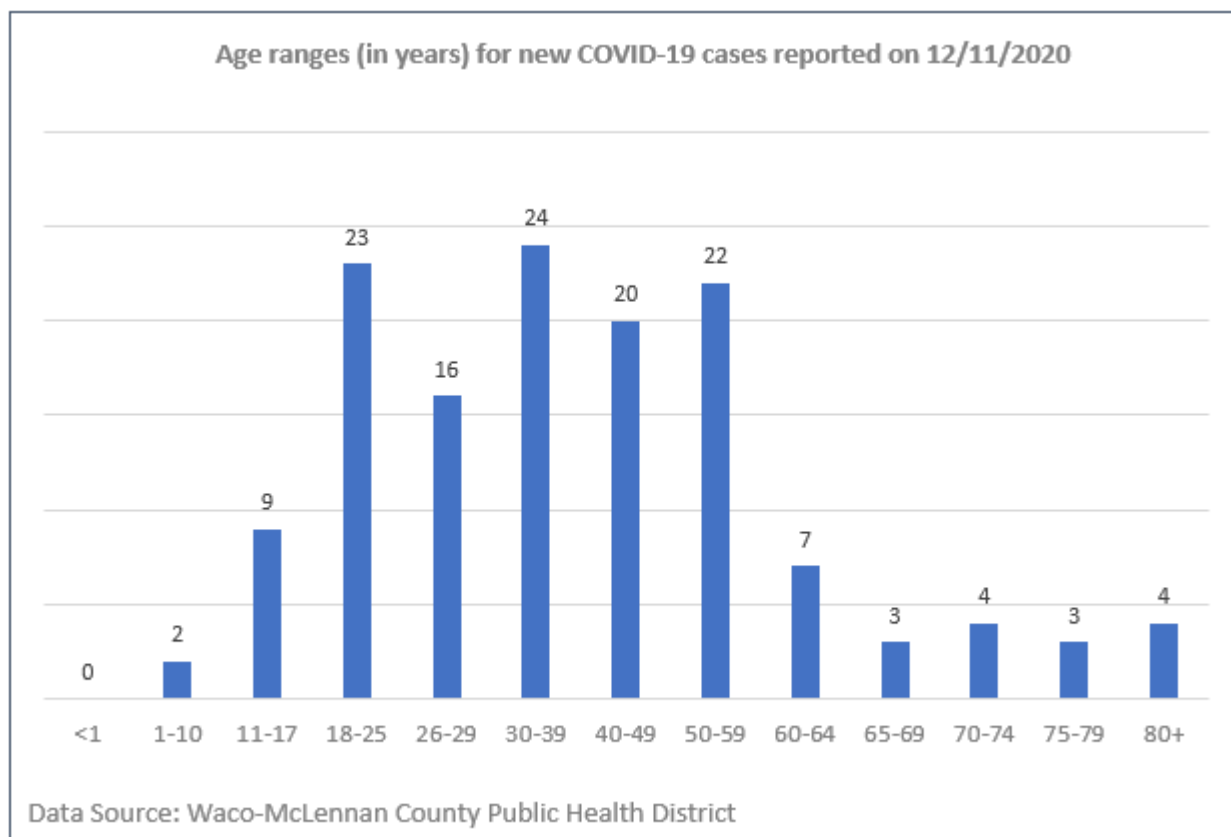
Sadly, four additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total deaths to 233.

#230 was a 45-year-old white female.

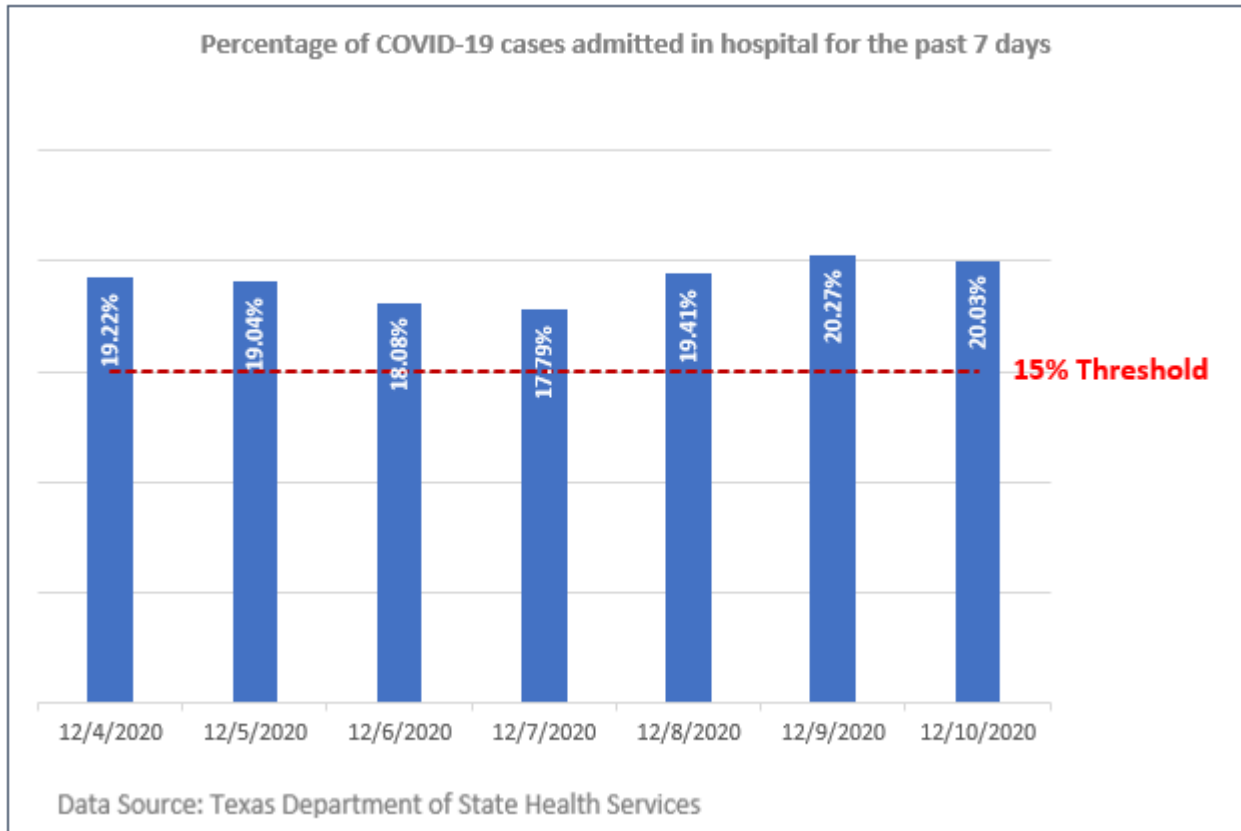
#231 was a 65-year-old white male.

As of December 10, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 20.03% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



**Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:**

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
