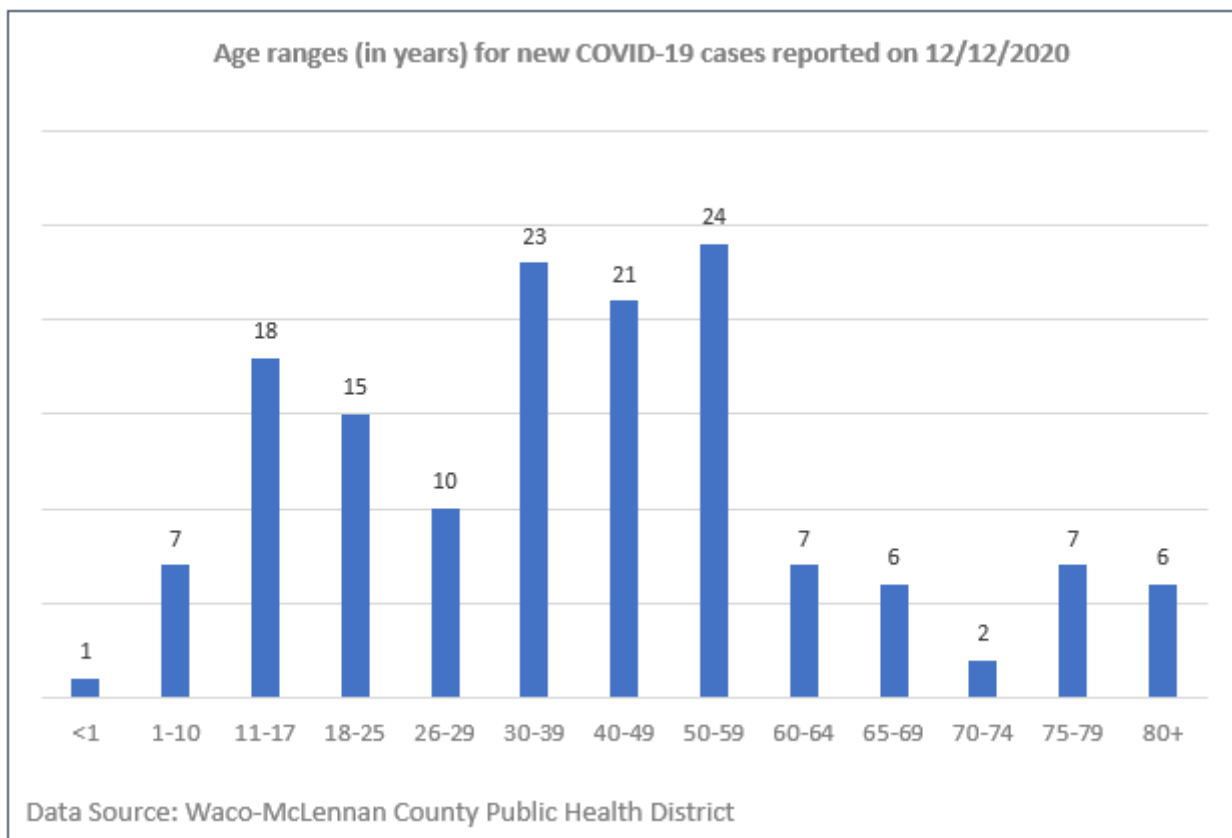

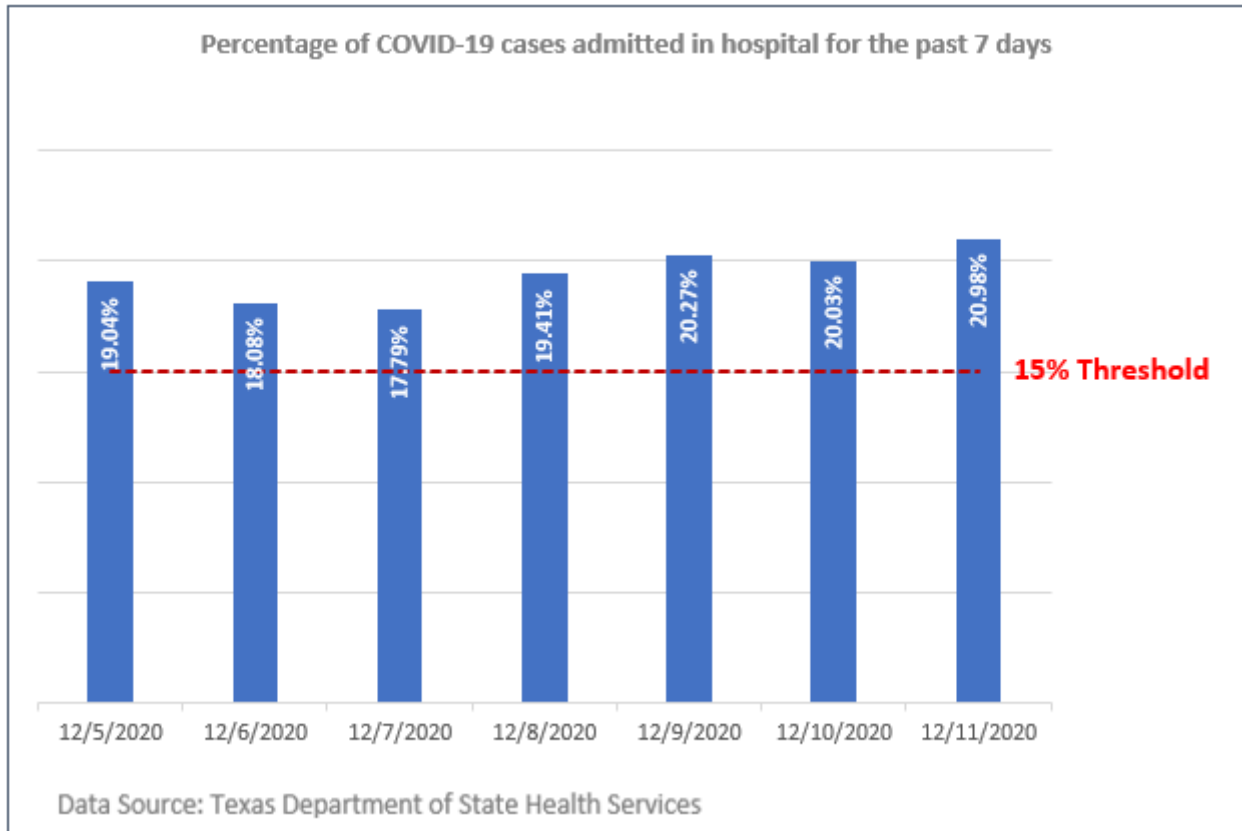
### Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 147 New Cases of COVID-19 Free Testing Locations for Dec 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>

(December 12, 2020) One hundred and forty-seven new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Twenty cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 16,274. There are 975 estimated active cases, and 15,066 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and three cases are hospitalized. Of the 103 hospitalized, 81 cases are McLennan County residents. Thirteen are on ventilators. There are no new deaths to report. The total number of deaths is 233.

As of December 11, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 20.98% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



**Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:**

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
