John Kinnaird Elected to the National League of Cities Board of Directors

WACO, TEXAS (December 14, 2018) – John Kinnaird, Councilman of District Three of Waco, TX was elected to the National League of Cities (NLC) board of directors by NLC’s membership at the 2018 City Summit in Los Angeles.
