Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces COVID-19 Statistics from December 13th and 14th Next TWO days free testing locations

(December 14, 2020) Due to the fact that the Health District did not report COVID-19 statistics on Sunday, the information is broken out for each day as shown below.

Sunday, December 13, 2020: Ninety-two new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed on Sunday. Forty-three cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases was 16,366. There were 875 estimated active cases, and 15,256 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred cases were hospitalized. Of the 100 hospitalized, 72 cases are McLennan County residents. Twelve were on ventilators.

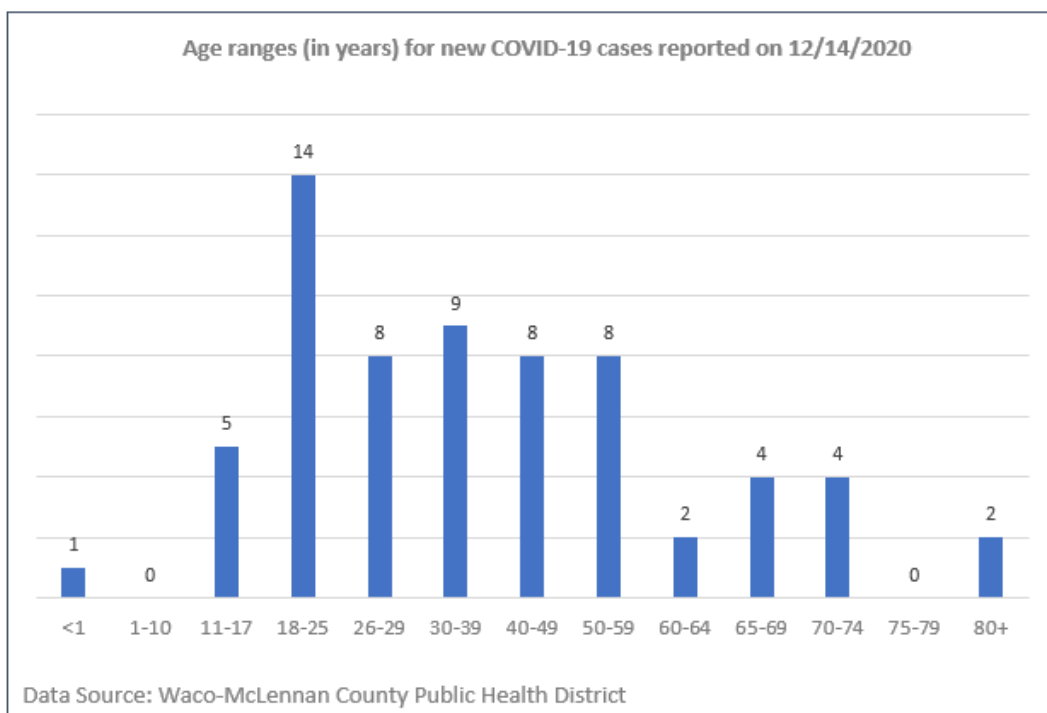
Monday, December 14, 2020: Sixty-five new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. No cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 16,431. There are 742 estimated active cases, and 15,453 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and eight cases are hospitalized. Of the 108 hospitalized, 77 cases are McLennan County residents. Fifteen are on ventilators.

Sadly, three additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19 over the weekend, bringing the total deaths to 236.

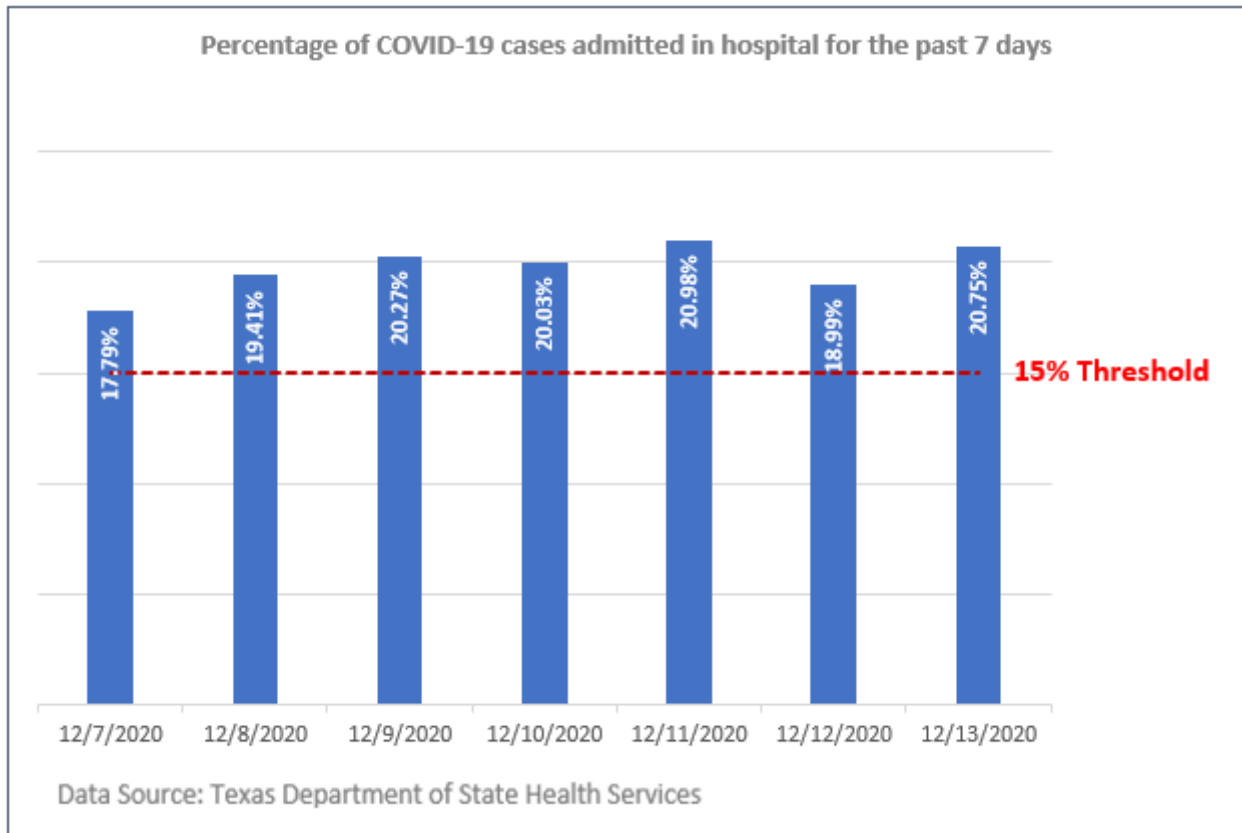
#234 was a 58-year-old white female.

As of December 13, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 20.75% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
