Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces 139 New Cases of COVID-19 3 Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19 Next TWO days free testing locations

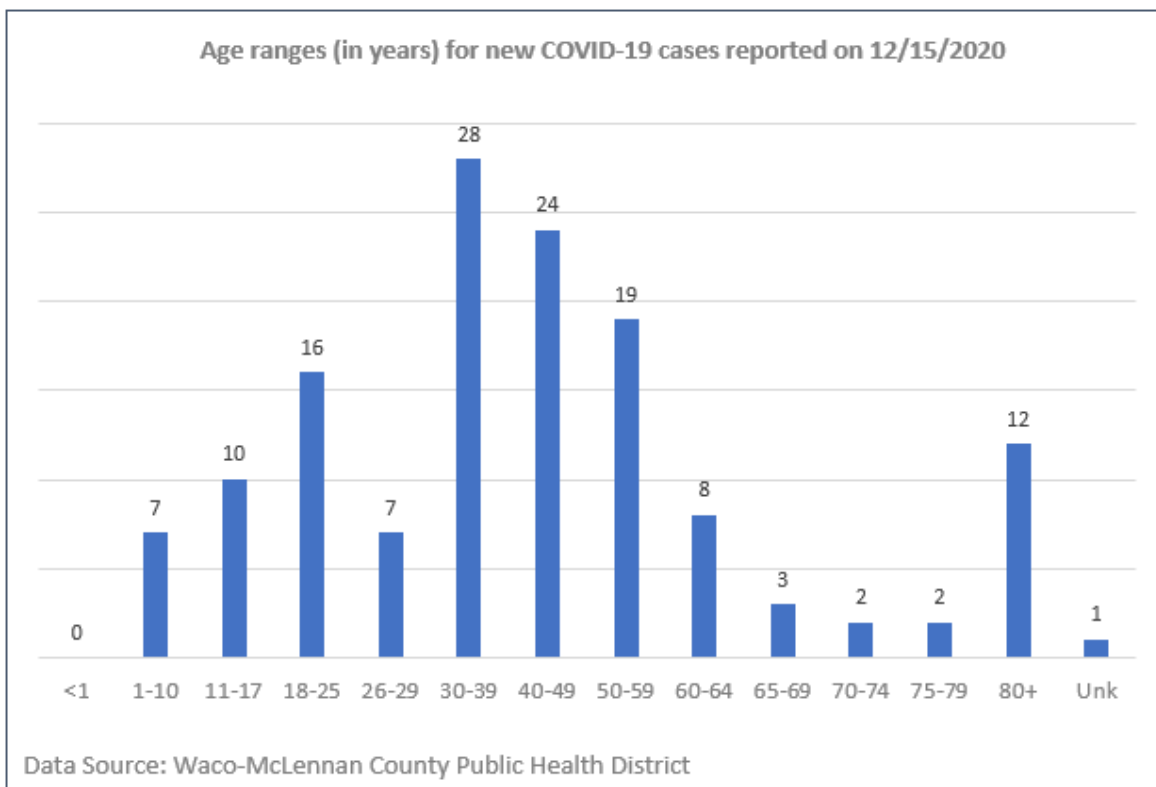
(December 15, 2020) One hundred and thirty-nine new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. No cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 16,570. There are 831 estimated active cases, and 15,500 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and sixteen cases are hospitalized. Of the 116 hospitalized, 81 cases are McLennan County residents. Nineteen are on ventilators.

Sadly, three additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total deaths to 239.

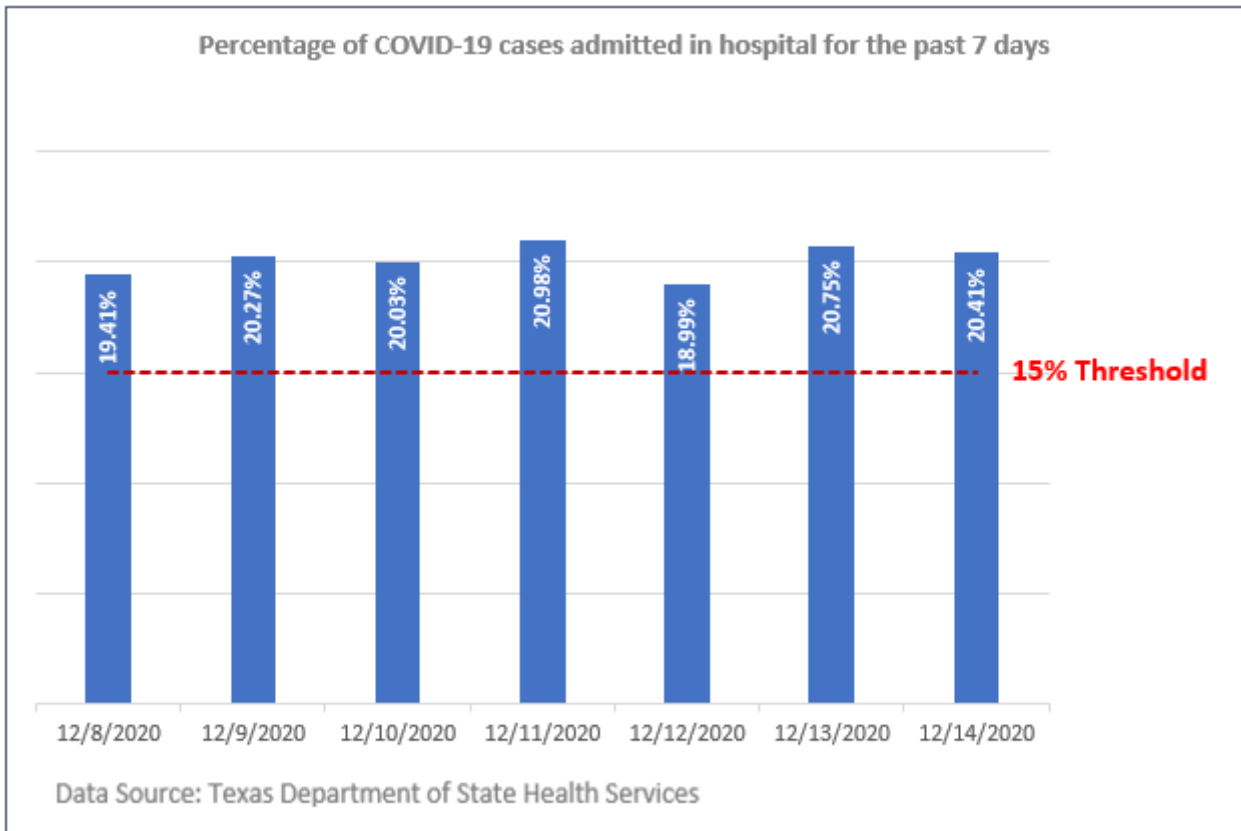
#237 was a 66-year-old male, race and ethnicity unknown.

#238 was a 56-year-old African-American male.

#239 was a 76-year-old white female.



As of December 14, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 20.41% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
