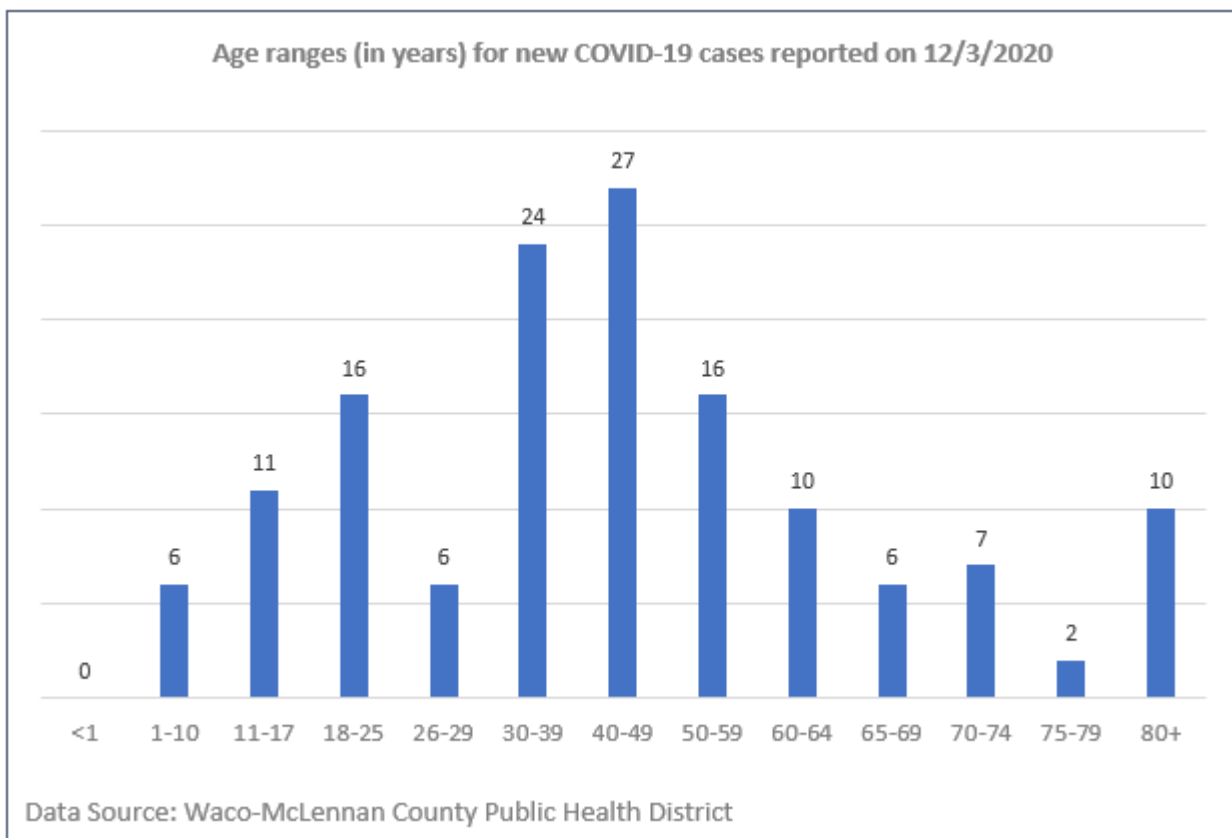
Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces

- 141 New Cases of COVID-19
- 2 Additional Deaths Attributed to COVID-19
- Friday free testing locations

(December 3, 2020) One hundred and forty-one new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Thirty-seven new cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 14,813. There are 756 estimated active cases, and 13,852 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and six cases are hospitalized. Of the 106 hospitalized, 70 cases are McLennan County residents. Seventeen are on ventilators. Sadly, 2 additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total deaths to 205.

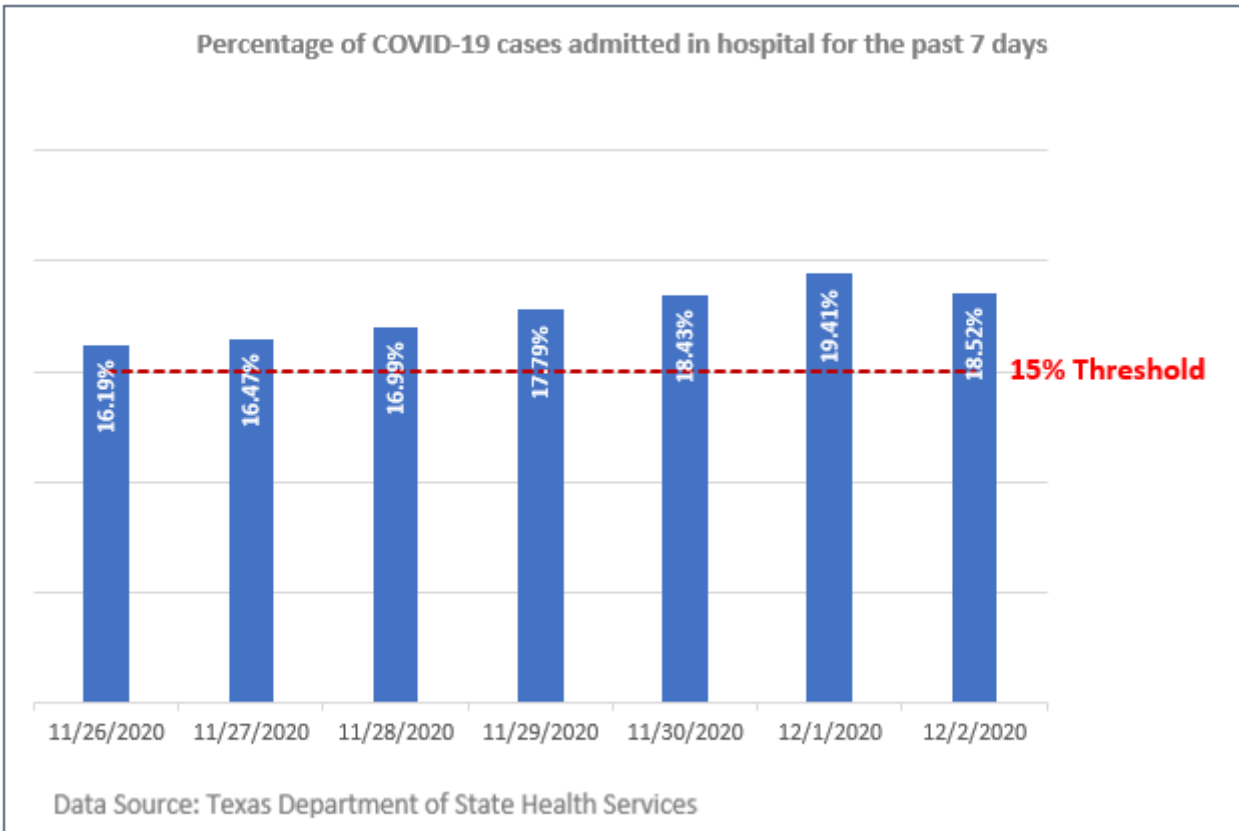

As of December 2, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 18.52% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
