


- 155 New Cases of COVID-19
- 1 Additional Death Attributed to COVID-19
- Free Testing Locations for Dec 7th and 8th

(December 5, 2020) One hundred and fifty-five new cases of COVID-19 are confirmed as of today. Thirty-two new cases were reported from community testing. The total number of cases to date is 15,092. There are 767 estimated active cases, and 14,114 estimated cases who have recovered. One hundred and eight cases are hospitalized. Of the 108 hospitalized, 74 cases are McLennan County residents. Twenty are on ventilators. Sadly, 1 additional death was reported due to COVID-19, bringing the total deaths to 211.

#211 was a 71-year-old African American female.



As of December 4, 2020, the hospitalization rate is 19.22% for Trauma Service Area M, as calculated by Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS). The rate has exceeded the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



Executive Order GA-32 calls for the following, based on a seven-day period:

- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is under 15% for 7 consecutive days, restaurants and other venues can operate at 75% capacity and elective surgeries are allowed.
- If the hospitalization rate in a Trauma Service Areas (TSA) with a COVID-19 hospitalizations rate is over 15% % for 7 consecutive days, venue capacities are lowered to 50% and elective surgeries are postponed until further notice.
