Boil Water Notice for Old Lorena Rd. - Chapel Rd. Area

Waco, Texas (December 6, 2019) – Due to a line break and resulting low/no water pressure in the area, the City of Waco water system (PWS#1550008) is notifying City of Waco Water customers in areas west of Old Lorena Rd, north of Lorena Meadows Drive, and south of Cottonbelt Trail, including: Haley Hill Rd., River View Dr., El Gato Ln., Longhorn Dr., Leutwyler Ln., Cecil Ln., Longhorn Dr., Armadillo Dr., Possum's End, Rabbit Hill Rd., Crooked Creek Rd., Marcy Ln., Jaun Diego Rd., Belver Rd., Eagle Crest, Fox Ridge, Pence Dr., Summer Harvest Dr., and Mourning Dove Ln. of the need to boil their water prior to consumption (e.g., washing hands/face, brushing teeth, drinking, etc). Children, seniors, and persons with weakened immune systems are particularly vulnerable to harmful bacteria, and all affected customers should follow these directions.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from another suitable source for drinking water or human consumption.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will issue a notice rescinding this boil water notice. The rescinding notice will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
