(February 12, 2021) Forty-six new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. Sadly, one additional death was reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 391 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of February 10, 2021 was 13.02%.
