Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces COVID-19 Statistics and Free Testing Locations

(February 15, 2021) Twenty-three new cases of COVID-19 were reported for Sunday and Monday. Case count information for Monday was not complete at time of press release. No additional deaths were reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 392 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of February 13, 2021 was 12.75%.
