**CITIZENS MUST CONSERVE WATER
AND REPORT LEAKS**

(February 18, 2021) Due to high customer use and system leaks from broken pipes, the City's water plants are struggling to produce enough water to maintain adequate pressure. The City asks all Wacoans and residents of customer cities of Robinson, Woodway, Hewitt, Bellmead, Lacy Lakeview and West to assist the City by taking the following steps IMMEDIATELY.

Here is what we need all citizens to do:

1. Conserve water for 48 hours. Do not use clothes washing machine or dishwasher. Do not hoard water by filling buckets, bathtubs, etc.
2. Report leaks you see to 254-299- 2489.
3. If your house or business has a leak, turn off the water valve to your building. If you don't have a valve or can't find it, call 254-299-2489 immediately and request someone to come turn off your water at the meter.
