(February 24, 2021) Seventy new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. Sadly, two new deaths were reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 397 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of February 22, 2021 was 10.88%.
