(February 26, 2021) Fifty-eight new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. Sadly, one new death has been reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 407 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of February 24, 2021 was 10.17%.
