Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces COVID-19 Statistics and Free Testing Locations

(March 1, 2021) One hundred and eight new cases of COVID-19 were reported over the weekend and today. Sadly, three new deaths were reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 410 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of February 27, 2021 was 9.24%.
