Signals at 18th & Colcord Knocked Out Due to Traffic Crash

WACO, TX (March 11, 2020) - The signal cabinet at 18th and Colcord was hit and completely destroyed by a traffic crash Tuesday night. It will require a new base and new cabinet to be installed. Stop signs have been installed at this location until repairs can be made, which could be more than a week (weather permitting).

Drivers are encouraged to plan accordingly and find an alternate route for those traveling to minimize delays and traffic congestion.

Safety is a top priority at City of Waco, some simple steps to take are: slow down, pay attention, avoid distractions such as cell phones, be patient and plan ahead.
