City of Waco Announces Opportunities for Public Input on Affordable Housing

WACO, TEXAS (March 31, 2021) The City of Waco announced opportunities for the public to give input on affordable housing issues in the City. The City is currently preparing a Strategic Housing Plan that will guide future affordable housing development, investment, rehabilitation, and policy. The City intends to complete the plan by September 2021 and has scheduled a series of virtual meetings for April 2021 to obtain input from the public.

Stakeholder Meetings

Meetings for stakeholders who work or provide services in areas related to affordable housing will be held at three different times. The content will be the same at each meeting. Topics to be covered include services to the homeless, housing development, and employment and training. One meeting will be held in English and Spanish. Pre-registration is required.
