Waco-McLennan County Public Health District Announces COVID-19 Statistics and Free Testing Locations

(March 4, 2021) Fifty-four new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. Sadly, eighteen new deaths were reported due to COVID-19. Of the eighteen deaths, sixteen were previously unreported deaths from 2020. As of today, 432 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of March 2, 2021 was 6.68%.
