(March 5, 2021) This release will be the **last daily case count press release**. Case count information will continue to be updated daily on COVIDWaco.com.

Forty-four new cases of COVID-19 are reported today. Sadly, one new death was reported due to COVID-19. As of today, 433 deaths have been attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic in McLennan County. The hospitalization rate for Trauma Service Area M as of March 3, 2021 was 6.56%.
