

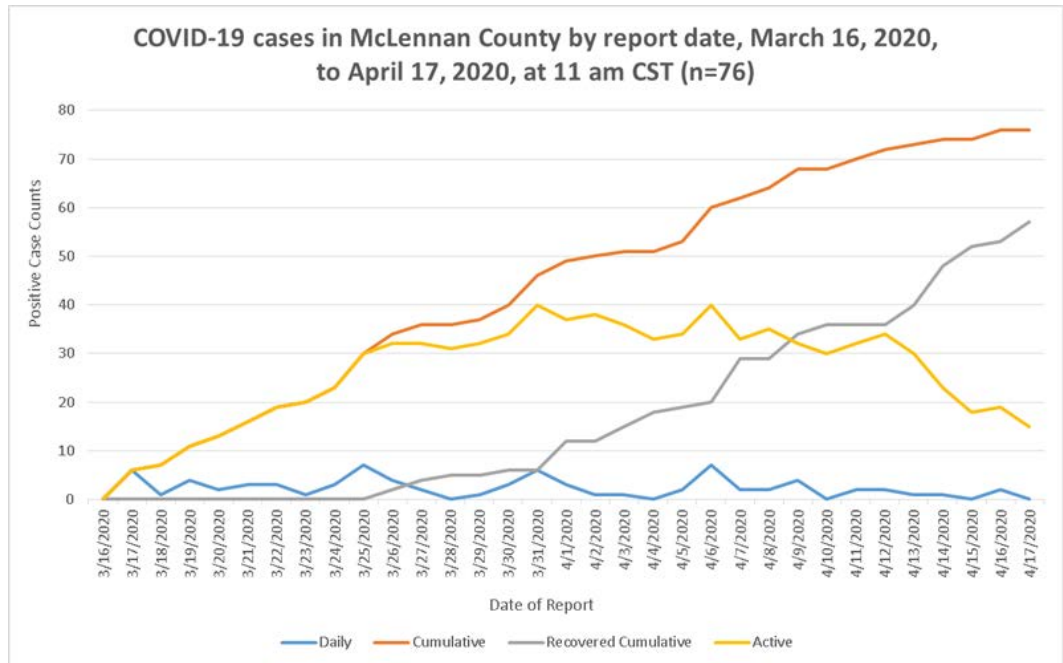


Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19 UPDATE AS OF April 17, 2020 at 3:00 pm.

There are 15 active cases.
57 cases have recovered.**

(April 17, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received NO new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 76.

- 2 cases are hospitalized, and both of these individuals are in critical condition
- 57 cases have recovered.
- 82 people are being actively monitored. This number includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.
