Great American Trash-Off April 7th in Waco

Waco, Texas (April 4, 2018) – Keep America Beautiful’s Great American Clean-up is the nation’s largest community improvement program, taking place annually each spring. This year is the event’s 20th Anniversary. Clean-up activities can include beautifying parks and recreation areas, cleaning waterways, handling recycling collections, picking up litter, and conducting educational programs — anything that keeps our community beautiful! The Don’t mess with Texas® Trash-Off serves as Texas’ signature event for the Great American Clean-up held annually in April.

Keep Waco Beautiful (KWB) in partnership with Baylor University Steppin’ Out, Waco Neighborhood Associations, Waco Parks and Recreation and Waco Solid Waste Services will conduct a clean-up on Saturday, April 7. For this clean-up event, there will be:

- Curbside services in Waco City Council District IV: Solid Waste Services will collect bulky waste, brush and extra trash from resident’s curb side in District IV on April 7th (Saturday) beginning at 7 AM. This event is for residential customers only. The remaining city council districts will receive this service at a date to be announced.
- FREE Residential Scrap Tire and Brush Chipping: A Parks and Recreation team with chippers will accept brush (self-haul) from Waco residents at Paul Tyson field. A roll-off will be available for free scrap tire collection for residential tires, up to 10. Waco residents must bring a Waco water bill for proof of residency.
- Neighborhood Association Clean-ups: Roll-off containers set at locations as requested by Waco Neighborhood Associations; Neighborhood Associations will be requesting roll-off containers are Alta Vista, Brookview, Brook Oaks, Carver and North East Riverside.
