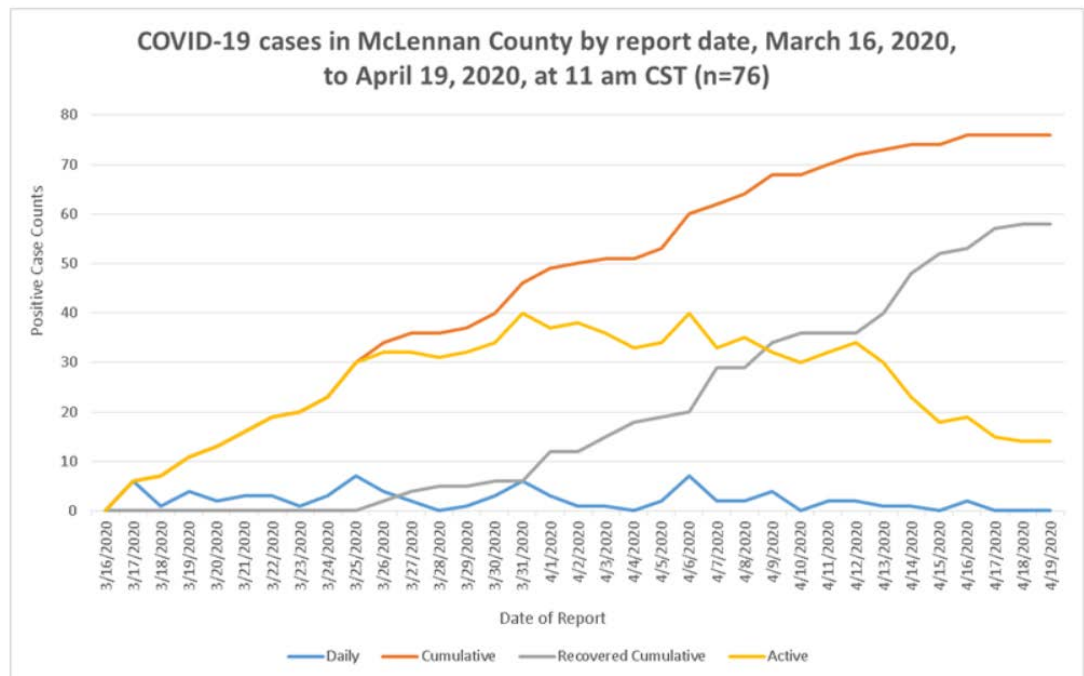
**No New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.

- 81 people are being actively monitored. This number includes positive cases and their close contacts.
