

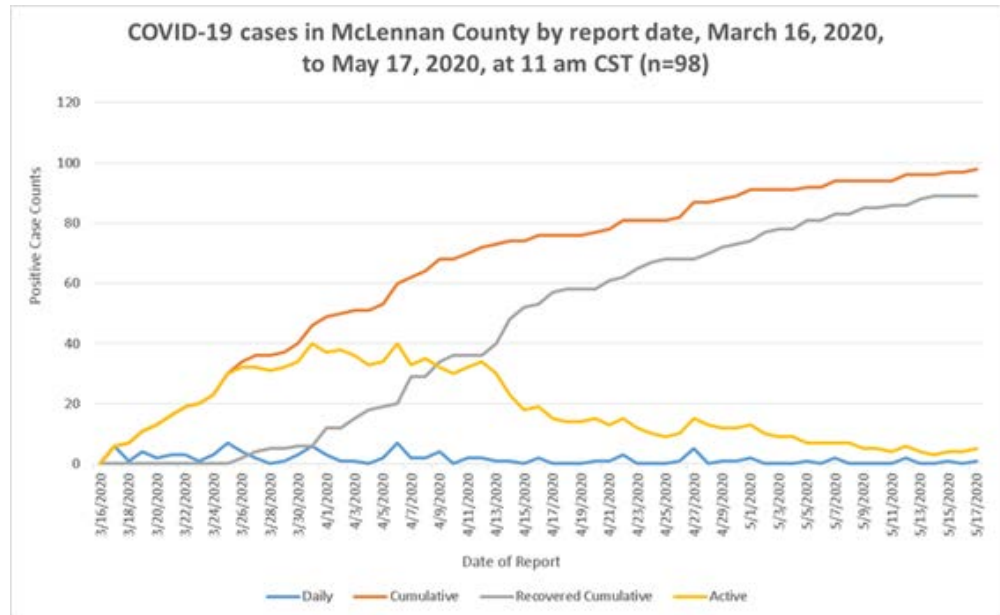


**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19  
UPDATE AS OF May 17, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**One New Case of COVID-19 has been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 98.  
There are 5 active cases.  
89 cases have recovered.**

(May 17, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received one new case of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 98, which includes 89 recovered, 4 deaths, and 5 active cases.

- 2 cases are hospitalized but not in critical condition.
- 89 cases have recovered. There are 5 active cases.
- 29 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.
