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WACO – The Waco Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is now receiving public comment on the Fiscal Year 2020 - 2021 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and proposed amendments to the Public Participation Plan (PPP).

The UPWP serves as the operating budget for the MPO and identifies the work tasks intended to be accomplished and the estimated costs to complete these tasks. The MPO is soliciting input regarding proposed tasks and whether other tasks should be considered. The PPP describes the efforts the MPO will undertake to solicit stakeholder and other interested party's involvement in the development of the MPO's plans and programs.

Two public informational meetings will be conducted to provide information regarding these documents and to accept comments from the public. Both meetings are scheduled for Monday, June 17th at the Waco Transit Administration Center – 301 S 8th Street. The first meeting begins at 12:00 Noon and the second meeting begins at 6:00 PM.
