(May 5, 2020) The Texas National Guard, in partnership with McLennan County, the City of Waco and the City of Bellmead, will be offering free drive-through COVID-19 testing sites on Friday, May 8 at two locations in McLennan County. The City of Waco testing site will be at the Waco Fire Station #5, located at 4515 Bagby Ave. The City of Bellmead testing site will be at the Bellmead Civic Center, located at 3900 Parrish St.

Participants will be screened for COVID-19 symptoms during registration.
