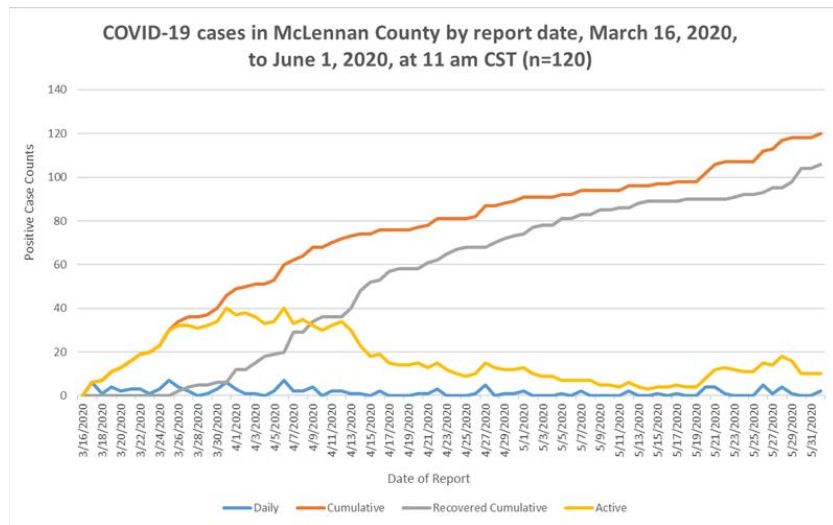
**Two New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 120.  
There are 10 active cases.  
106 cases have recovered.**

(June 1, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received two new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 120, which includes 106 recovered, 4 deaths, and 10 active cases.

- No cases are hospitalized.
- 106 cases have recovered. There are 10 active cases.
- 69 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.
