




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19  
UPDATE AS OF June 14, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**Five New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 163.  
There are 35 active cases.  
124 cases have recovered.**

(June 14, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received five new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 163, which includes 124 recovered, 4 deaths, and 37 active cases.

- 5 cases are hospitalized
  - 4 are in critical condition.
  - 2 of the 4 cases are McLennan County residents.
- 124 cases have recovered. There are 37 active cases.
- 181 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.



**Age groups for June 14th release:**

- 1 case is in the 20-29 age range.
- 1 case is in the 40-49 age range.
- 1 case is in the 50-59 age range.
- 2 cases are in the 60 and over age range.
