




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF June 17, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**Twenty-Six New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 222.
There are 86 active cases
132 cases have recovered.**

(June 17, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received twenty-six new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 222, which includes 132 recovered, 4 deaths, and 86 active cases.

- 9 cases are hospitalized
 - 4 are in critical condition.
 - 4 of the 9 cases are McLennan County residents.
- 132 cases have recovered. There are 86 active cases.
- 335 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.



Age groups for June 17th release:

- 2 cases are in the 0-19 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 4 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 2 cases are in the 60 and over age range.
