




**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19
UPDATE AS OF June 18, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**Twenty-Three New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 245
There are 105 active cases.
135 cases have recovered.**

(June 18, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received twenty-three new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 245, which includes 135 recovered, 5 deaths, and 105 active cases.

- 6 cases are hospitalized
 - 3 are in critical condition.
 - 3 of the 6 cases are McLennan County residents.
- 135 cases have recovered. There are 105 active cases.
- 400 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 5 deaths in McLennan County.

- 1 case is in the 0-10 age range.
- 1 case is in the 11-19 age range.
- 9 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 3 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 4 cases are in the 40-49 age range.
- 5 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
