

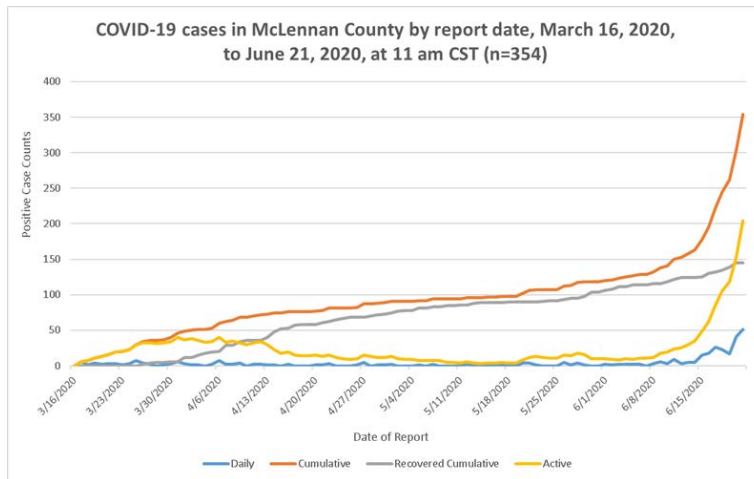


**Waco-McLennan County Public Health District COVID-19  
UPDATE AS OF June 21, 2020 at 3:00 pm.**

**Fifty-One New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.  
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 354.  
There are 204 active cases.  
145 cases have recovered.**

(June 21, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received fifty-one new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 354, which includes 145 recovered, 5 deaths, and 204 active cases.

- 9 cases are hospitalized
  - 7 are in critical condition.
  - 7 are McLennan County residents
- 145 cases have recovered. There are 204 active cases.
- 712 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 5 deaths in McLennan County.



**Age groups for June 21st release:**

- 2 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 8 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 15 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 9 cases are in in the 40-49 age range.
- 5 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 6 cases are in the 60-69 age range.
