The first patient was a 53-year-old, Hispanic male. He died at a local hospital on Sunday, June 28, 2020. The 2nd patient was an 89-year-old, white male. He died at a local hospital on Monday morning, June 29, 2020.

There have been a total of 8 fatalities attributed to COVID-19 in McLennan County.

The Public Health District continues to take every action to protect and to inform the residents of McLennan County and we encourage residents to bear in mind the potential cost of the virus' spread. COVID-19 affects every sector of our community.
