The count for 6-28-20 has been finalized at 47 cases.


The Total Number of Cases to Date is 795.

(June 29, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received 51 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 795, which includes 195 recovered, 8 deaths, and 592 active cases.

- 28 cases are hospitalized
 - o 19 cases are McLennan County residents
 - o 3 cases are on ventilators
- 195 cases have recovered. There are 592 active cases.
- 617 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
