
**Two New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 125.
There are 10 active cases.
111 cases have recovered.**

(June 4, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has received two new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 125, which includes 111 recovered, 4 deaths, and 10 active cases.

- 1 case is hospitalized and in critical condition.
- 111 cases have recovered. There are 10 active cases.
- 40 people are being actively monitored, which includes positive cases and their close contacts.
- 4 deaths in McLennan County.

- 258 negative test results
- 30 pending tests
- 0 positive tests results
