Today's Case Count may not accurately reflect the total.


**95 New Cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed as of this update.
The Total Number of Cases to Date is 2537.**

There are 2097 active cases.

424 cases have recovered.

(July 11, 2020) The Waco-McLennan County Public Health District has confirmed 95 new cases of COVID-19. The total number of cases is 2537, which includes 424 recovered, 16 deaths, and 2097 active cases.

- 59 cases are hospitalized
 - Of the 59 hospitalized, 50 cases are McLennan County residents. This information is being provided to inform residents about the use of local hospital resources.
 - 10 cases are on ventilators
- 424 cases have recovered. There are 2095 active cases.
- The Texas Department of State Health Services has taken on the monitoring function for all positive cases and direct contacts.
- 16 deaths in McLennan County.

- 2 cases are in the 0-10 age range.
- 17 cases are in the 11-19 age range.
- 14 cases are in the 20-29 age range.
- 21 cases are in the 30-39 age range.
- 13 cases are in in the 40-49 age range.
- 15 cases are in the 50-59 age range.
- 13 cases are the 60 and above age range.
